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Relevance

The Holy Nobleborn Prince Alexander Nevsky (1220-1263)




Research methods:

The young Prince's victory over the Swedes on July 15, 1240 at the mouth of the Izhora river on the banks of the Neva river brought him universal fame. It is believed that it was for this victory that the Prince was called Nevsky.

Having strengthened the Western borders,
Alexander was forced to completely
immerse himself in "Eastern Affairs".



By making concessions and establishing
diplomatic relations with the Horde, he
saved a weakened Russia from complete
destruction.

- The Alexander Nevsky was canonized as a Saint.
- Veneration of Alexander Nevsky as a Saint began long before he was canonized by the Russian Orthodox Church in 1547.
- Where people earnestly asked him for a miracle, it always happened.





In memory of him, a monastery was built in St. Petersburg, the Alexander Nevsky Lavra, where in 1724, by decree of Peter the Great, his relics were transported.

In 1725, Empress Catherine I established the order of St. Alexander Nevsky, which was awarded for services in both military and civil service. It is made of gold, silver, diamonds, ruby glass and enamel.



Who received the order of Alexander Nevsky?



In 1942, the order of Alexander Nevsky was also established, which was awarded to Red Army officers for their personal bravery and ensuring the successful actions of their units. The order of Alexander Nevsky is one of the highest awards in Russia.






