¿Cuánto es? – Сколько стоит?

Если вопросительное слово ¿Cuánto? Употребляется с существительным, то тогда оно согласуется с ним в роде и числе:

- ¿Cuánt**os** años tienes? – Сколько тебе лет?
(дословно: сколько лет ты имеешь?)
- ¿Cuánt**as** casas tiene usted? – Сколько у Вас домов?
- ¿Cuánt**os** coches tiene este señor? – Сколько машин у этого сеньора?

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¿Cuál / Quáles? – какой, который / какие, которые?

Наиболее употребительно в вопросах типа:

- **¿Cuál es tu número de teléfono?** – Какой у тебя номер телефона?
- **¿Cuál es su dirección?** – Какой у Вас адрес?
- **¿Cuál es tu nacionalidad?** – Какая у тебя национальность?

Такие вопросы можно задавать по другому:

- **¿Qué número de teléfono tienes?** – Какой у тебя номер телефона? (досл. Какой номер телефона имеешь?)
