They had finished the work by 6 o'clock yesterday. — Они закончили работу вчера к 6 часам.

Mary had got asleep before her mother came home.— Мэри уснула прежде, чем её мама пришла домой.

Past Perfect образуется с помощью вспомогательного глагола **had** и III формы основного глагола.





The Past Perfect Tense

- by 5 o'clock к 5 часам
- by Saturday к субботе
- by the 1-st of September к 1 сентября
- by the end of the week/year/month к концу недели/года/месяца
- by that time к тому времени
- already уже (в утверждениях)
- yet уже (в вопросах), ещё не (в отрицаниях) и т.д.
