- In the 1970s, times were hard. Unemployment was growing higher and higher, especially amongst the young, and many teenagers felt that society was to blame.



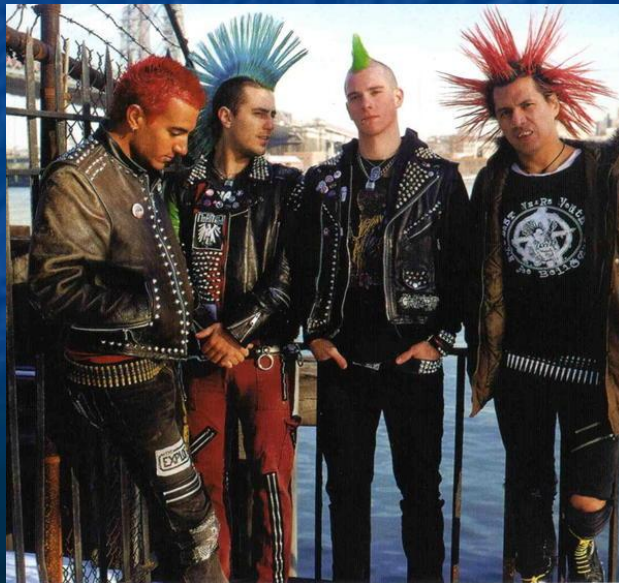
A youth culture

- Punks chose clothes that their parents hated. They wore ripped T-shirts, Doc Marten boots and leather jackets, and often had brightly coloured spiked hair.



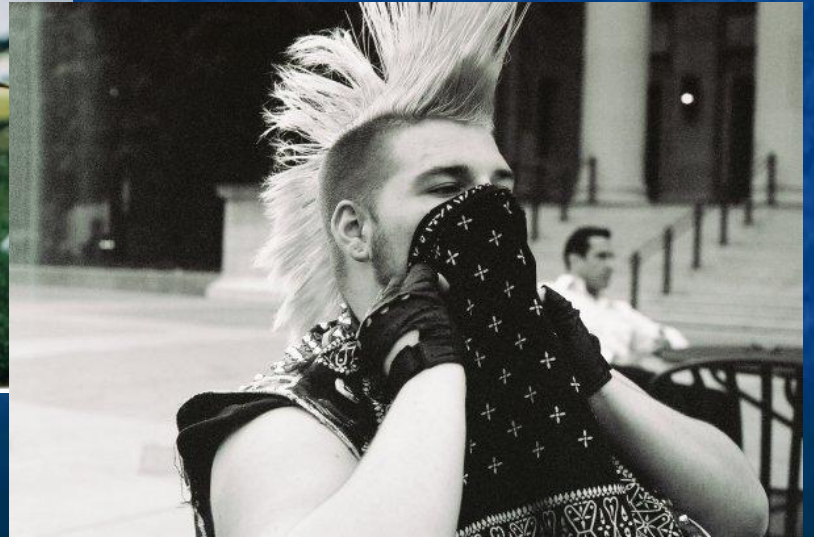
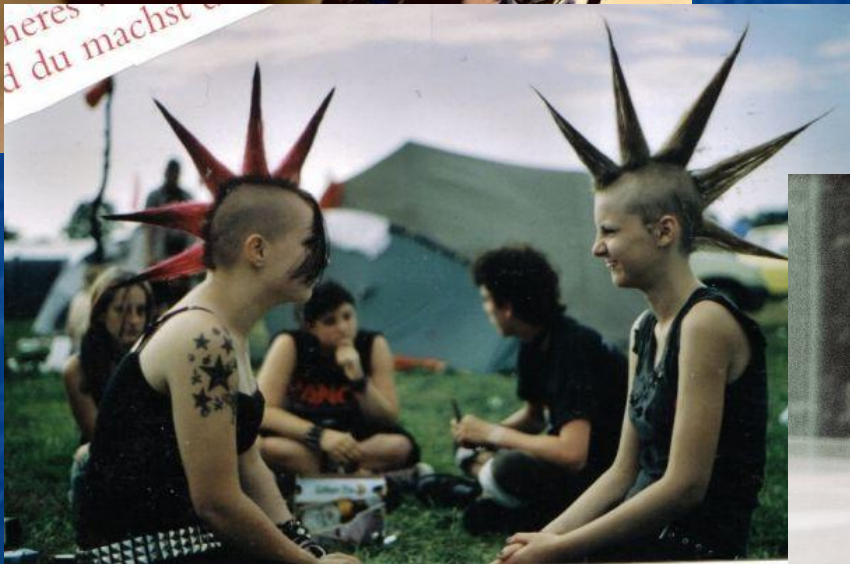
