Apples are delicious fall fruits.



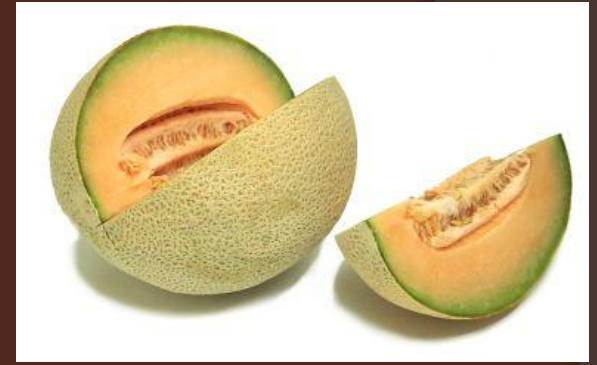

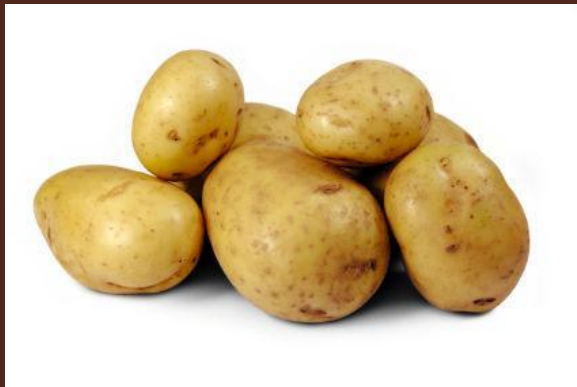

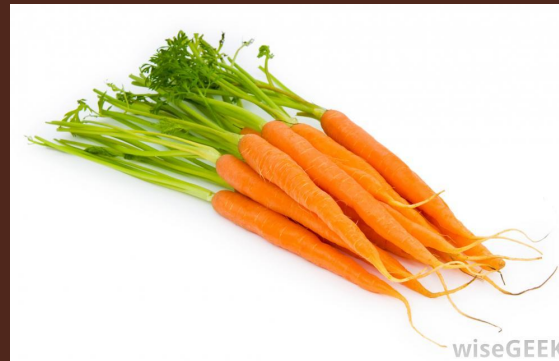
