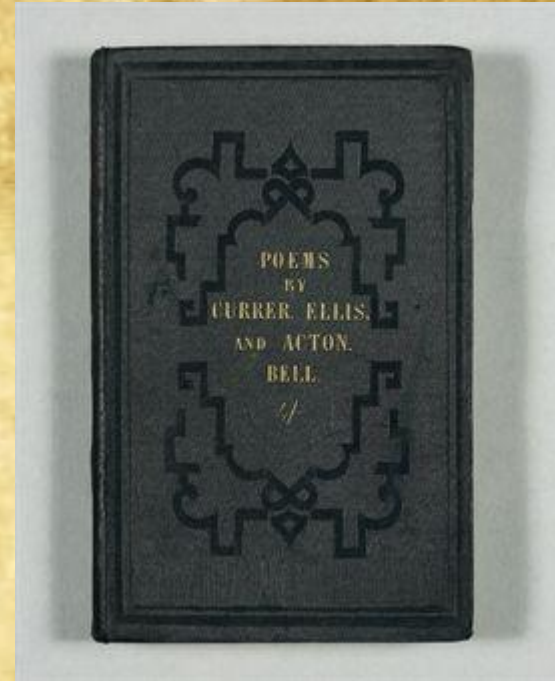
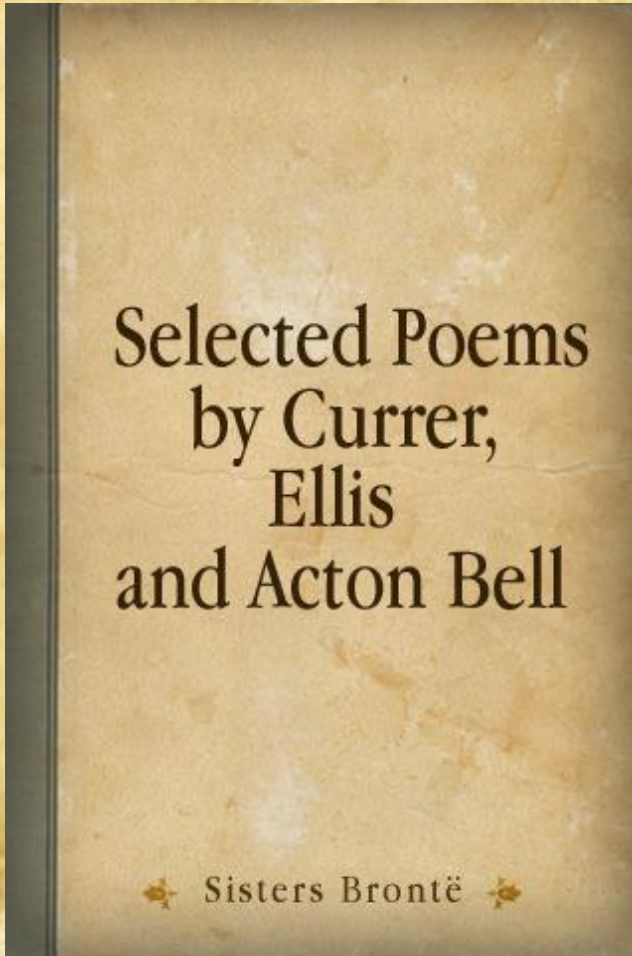
# Emily Bronte



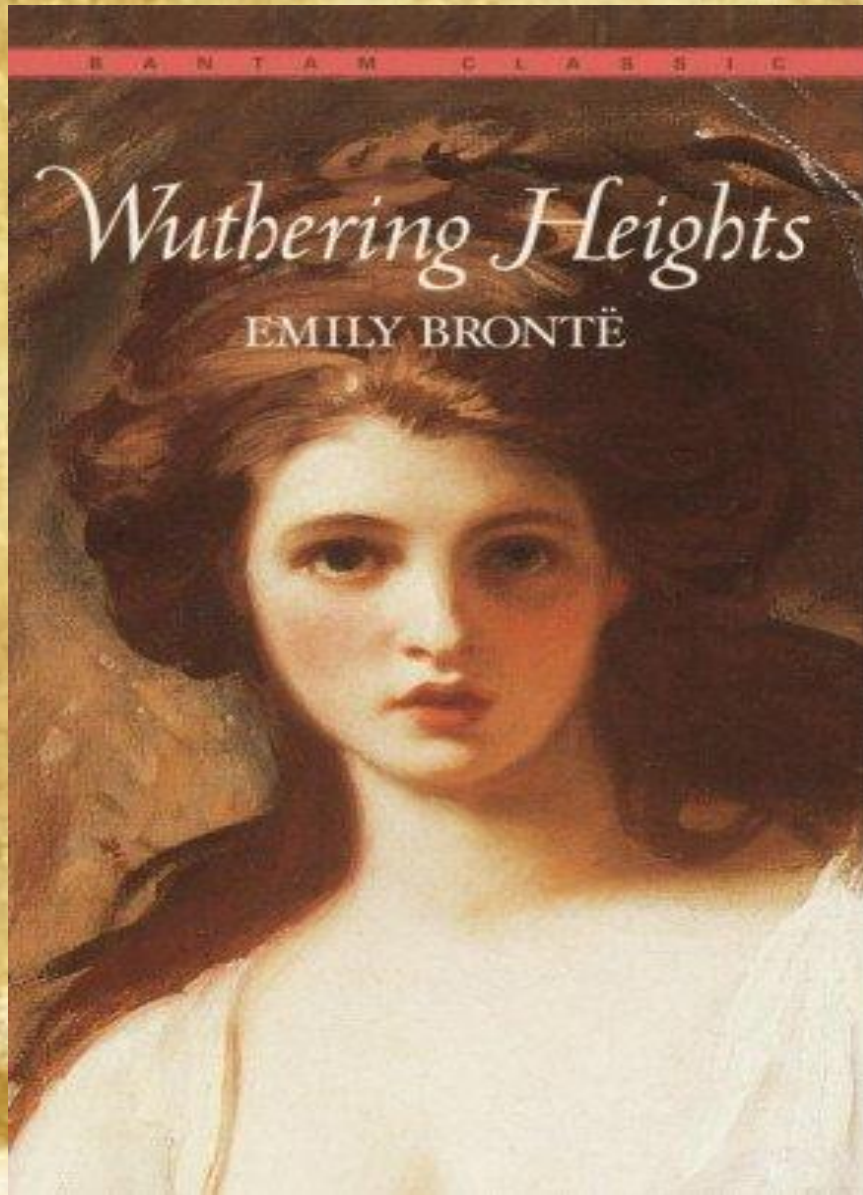
Emily and her siblings became very close, especially she and her sister Anne.



Emily returned to school at the age of seventeen; however, after three months, she returned home..



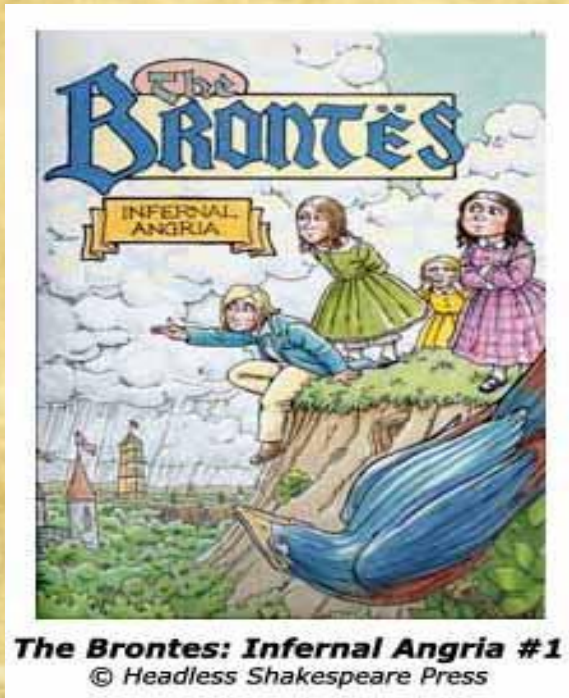
Charlotte, Emily, and Anne published a collection titled Poems by Currer, Ellis and Acton



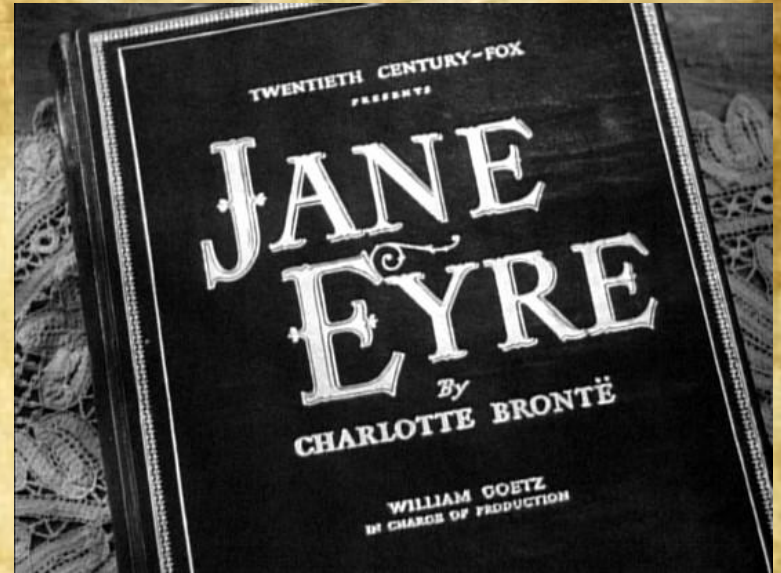
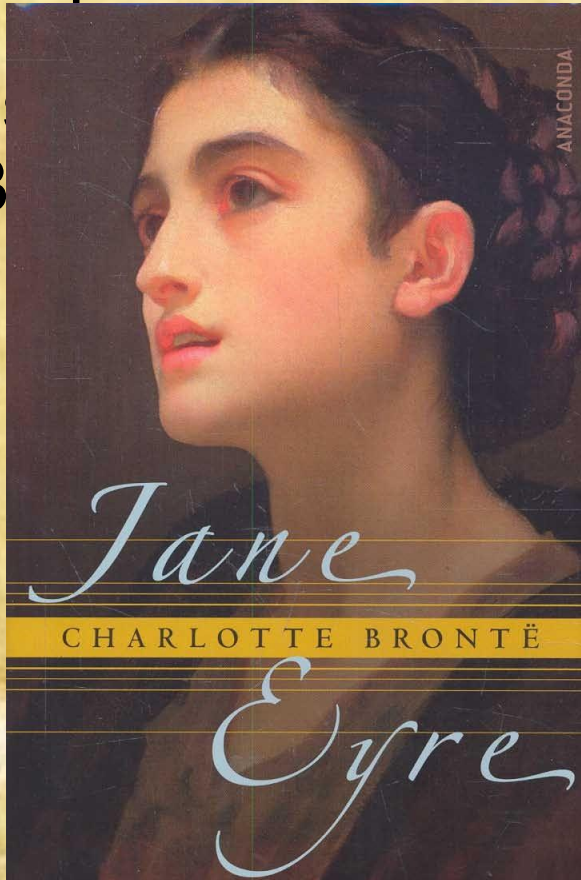
Wuthering Heights, Emily's only published novel, was not well received at first.

Charlotte's most famous work, Jane Eyre (1847), was originally published under the pseudonym Currer Bell.





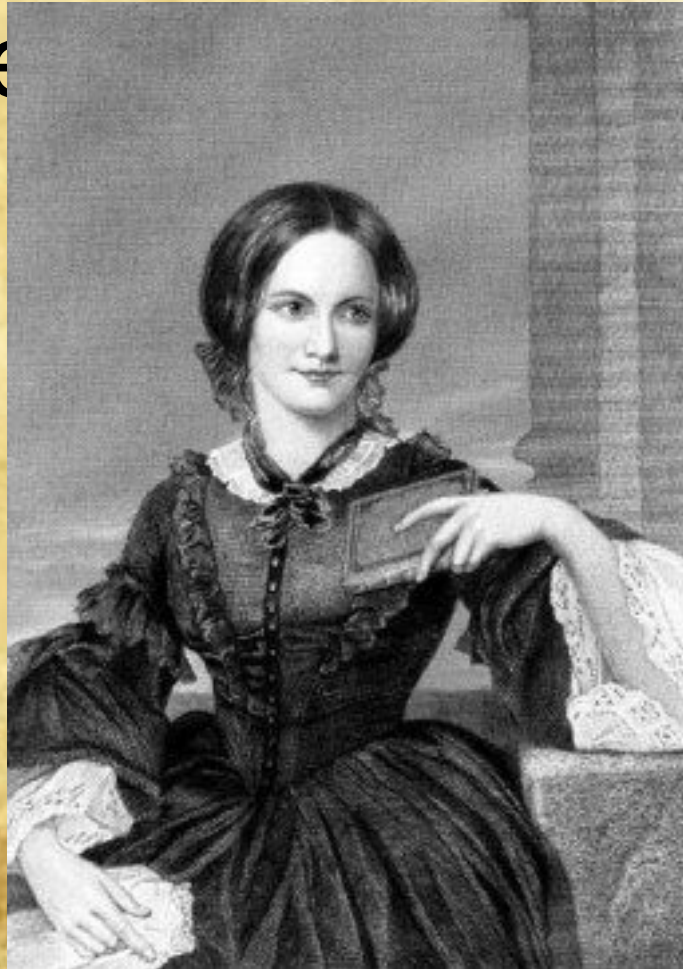

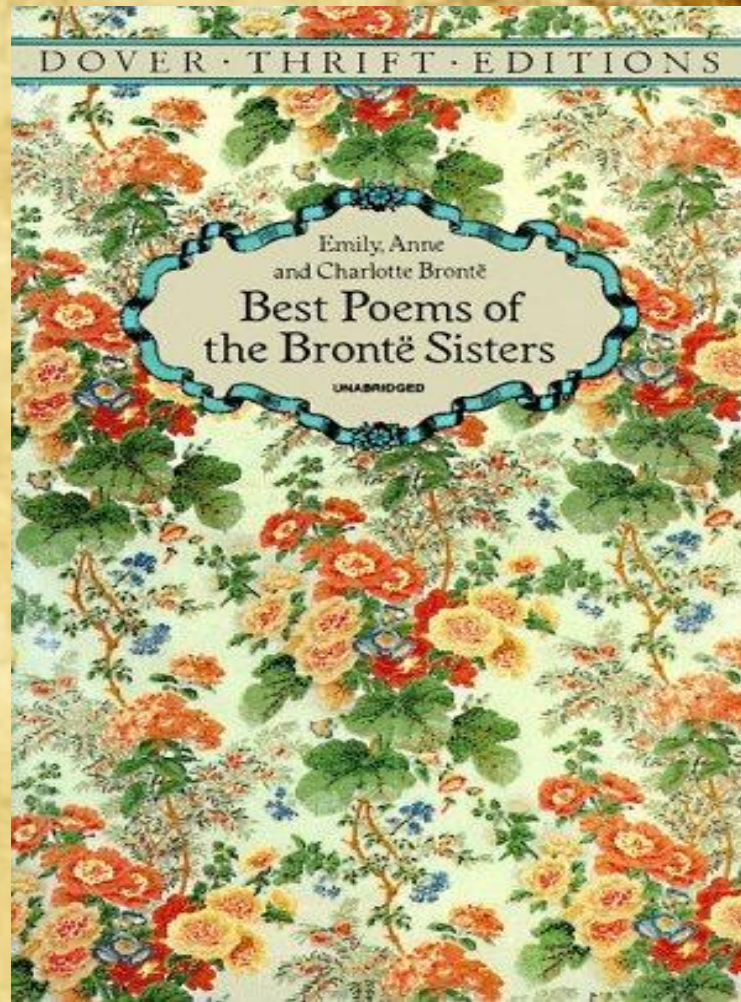
