



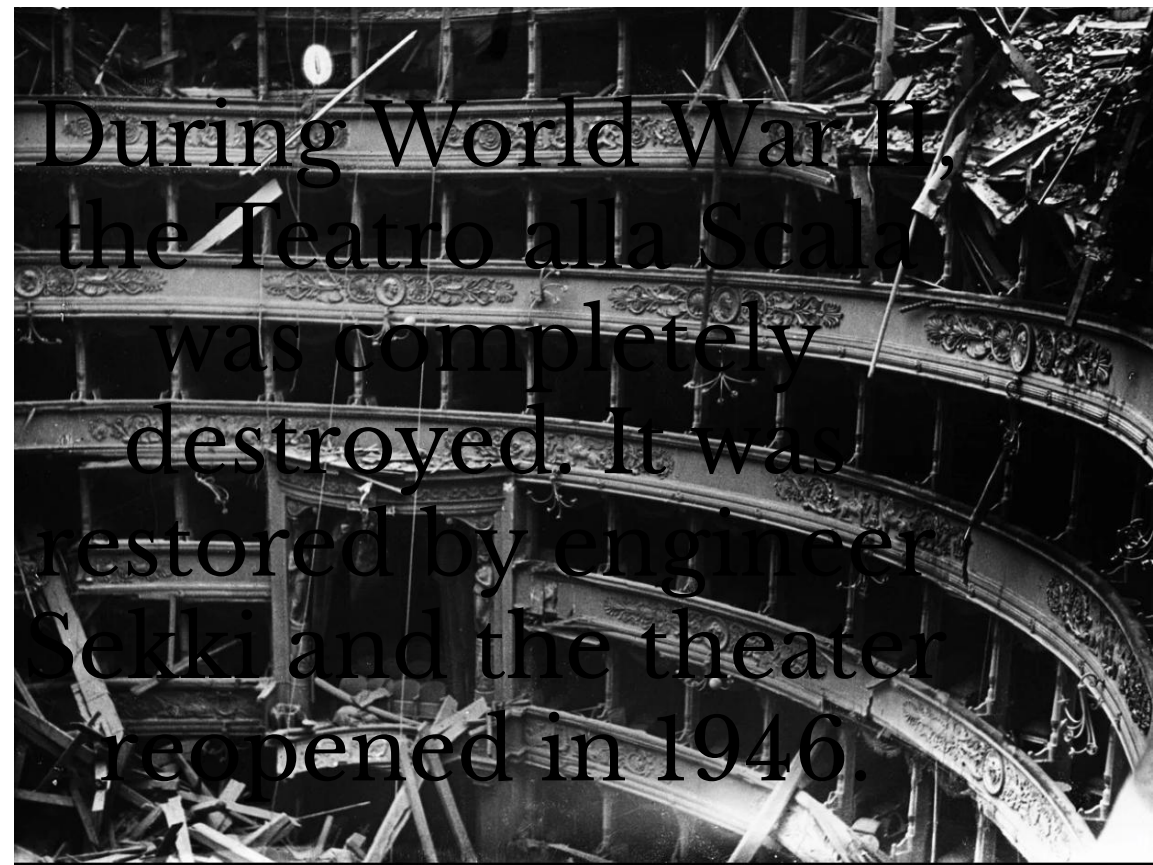
# *La Scala de Milan*

reopened in 1946.



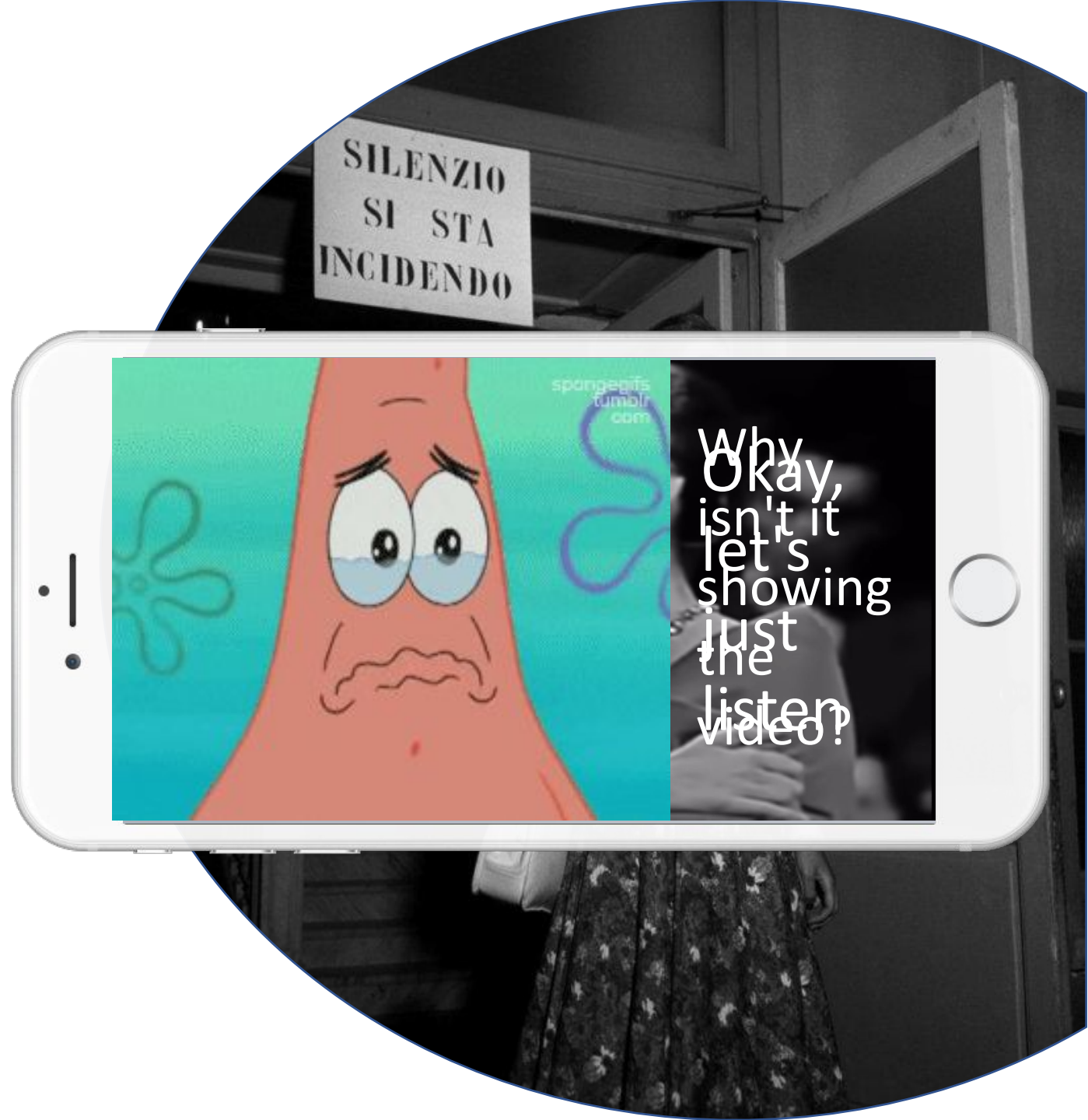




# Maria Callas

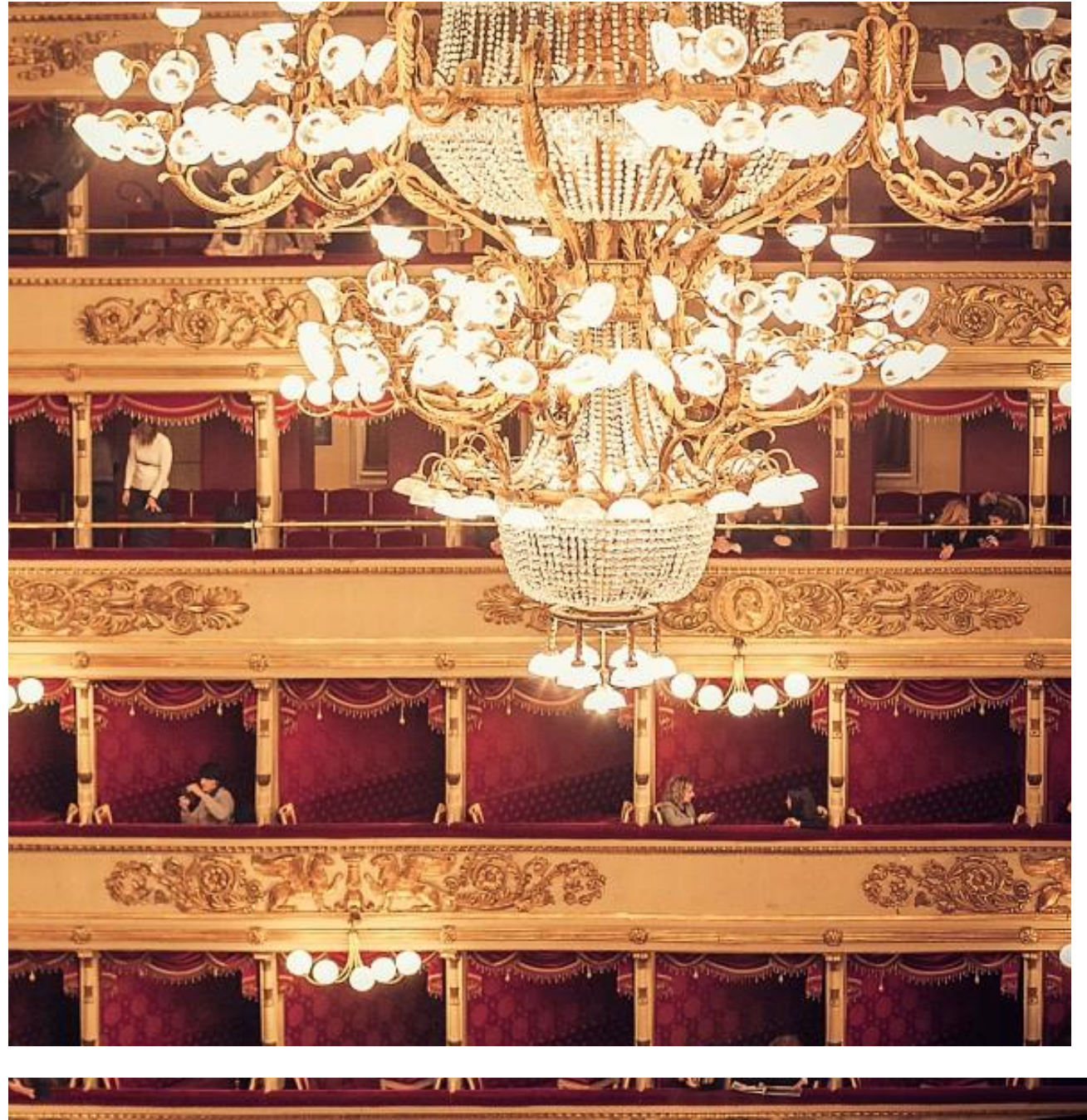
Teatro alla Scala was the first theater in the world to be given electric light. On the night of St. Stephen's 1883 (December 25-26) in honor of the premiere of Ponchielli's La Gioconda, 2,450 light bulbs were lit at once in the theater.



# Chandelier

---

One of the theater's primaries is a luxurious chandelier made of Bohemian crystal and sparkling with 400 bulbs. Unfortunately, the chandelier that we see today is just a copy of the real one, created after the bombing of the Second World War.

# Gambling

In the early 800s, it was customary to play cards before and after performances at the Teatro alla Scala. The 700 parterre seats have been designed to be movable to create free play space. Alessandro Manzoni almost lost himself to one of the Milanese aristocrats in the Teatro alla Scala.





# Applause Agency

As in Paris, Milan also had agencies that provided men's professional cost 25 'impudens' men's Teatro La Scala management quite often used the services of such agencies to support opera singers.
