CLIMATE

- Madagascar's climate is highly variable. Generally, Madagascar has two seasons: a hot, rainy season from November to April and a cooler, dry season from May to October.



- Madagascar has some of the highest biodiversity on the planet. Unique to the island are more than 50 types of lemurs

- The aye-aye is one of the strangest creatures in the world. The aye-aye resembles a large house cat but with the face of a ferret, bat-like ears, teeth that grow constantly like those of a rodent, green eyes, and black hands



- Madagascar is home to 258 bird species of which 115 are found nowhere else in the world.



- Madagascar is thought to have more than 300 species of frogs, 99% of which are end

- Madagascar`s problems:
- Deforestation and habitat destruction
 - Agricultural fires
 - Erosion and soil degradation
 - Overexploitation of living resources including hunting and over-collection of some species of wild unusual animals and plants
