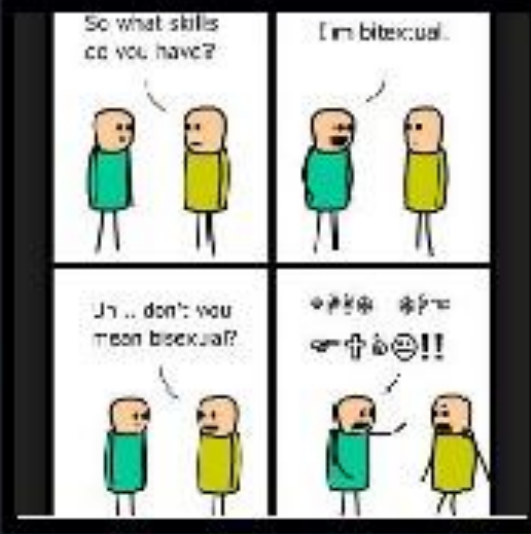

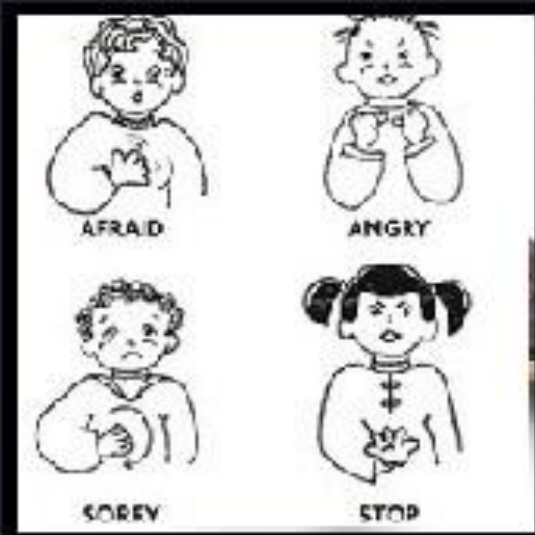

BILL – short for William, banknote, receipt, official and important document

BREAK – breakdance, break/damage something, break an egg, pause

COMIC – comic book, comedian, funny, comic as a joke

CRACKER – nutcracker, holiday/Christmas cracker, biscuit, and the last is a tough one! – „She’s a cracker!“ – idiomatic expression for „sexy“

CUTE

FULL – full moon, full stomach, full shopping trolley, glass full of water

GINGER – gingerbread man, ginger – spices, colour of hair (both woman and the cat)

KING – king of animals, Elvis Presley as a king of rock, king in cards and chess
