What is commodity science?

- **A commodity specialist** is a specialist in the quality, supply and sale of goods for various purposes (food, medicines, repair and finishing materials, etc.). a Commodity specialist carries out economic planning, organizes transportation, merchandising, and expert evaluation.
- **Commodity science** (German: Warenkunde) is a scientific discipline that focuses on the consumer properties of goods that underlie their use value.

The history of the profession of commodity specialist

M. Ya. Kittary

The founder of domestic commodity science. He pointed out the need to use the idea of classification into groups, which combined 209 individual types of goods.



P. P. Petrov

Founder of commodity science of non-food products. Introduced practical classes in commodity science.



The commodity specialist works in trade and public catering organizations. The product specialist is directly responsible for the acceptance of the product, its placement and compliance with standards and requirements. It studies the population's demand for goods, prepares orders for their delivery or even production. In addition, the commodity expert monitors the delivery of goods in the right range, of the appropriate quality and within the agreed time frame. Checks whether the quality of incoming goods meets the current State standards and technical conditions.



What does a commodity specialist ?

- responsible for compliance with the rules of storage of goods and packaging materials.
- works in industrial organizations, in finishing construction.
- provide the company with raw materials, equipment, and spare parts.
- makes the order, reception and delivery of materials, keeps records and documentation.

Requirements for specialist knowledge and skills

To successfully master the profession of a commodity specialist, needs basic knowledge of office management and Economics.
