#### We normally use -'s for people:

- I stayed at my sister's house. (not the house of my sister)
- Have you met Mr Black's wife? (not the wife of Mr Black)
- Are you going to James's party?
- Paul is a man's name. Paula is a woman's name.

#### You can use -'s without a noun after it:

- O Sophie's hair is longer than Kate's. (= Kate's hair)
- 'Whose umbrella is this?' 'It's my mother's.' (= my mother's umbrella)
- 'Where were you last night?' 'I was at Paul's.' (= Paul's house)

#### friend's and friends'

#### The power of grammar



my **friend's** house = one friend (= **his** house or **her** house)

We write 's after

friend/student/mother etc. (singular):

my mother's car (one mother)

my father's car (one father)



my **friends'** house = two or more friends (= **their** house)

We write 'after friends/students/parents etc. (plural): my parents' car (two parents)

We use of ... for things, places etc.:

- Look at the roof of that building (not that building's roof)
- We didn't see the beginning of the film. (not the film's beginning)
- What's the name of this village?
- Do you know the cause of the problem?
- You can sit in the back of the car.
