Russian Federation - the largest country in the world by area (17,075.4 thousand. Km²), a democratic federal state with a republican form of government.

Russian flag was born with the first Russian warships to the XIX century and remained belonging mainly naval culture.

Currently, the most commonly used treatment following values flag colors of Russia:

- White - means peace, purity, chastity, goodness;**
- Blue - the color of faith and fidelity, constancy;**
- Red - symbolizes energy, strength, blood shed for their country.**

The modern interpretation of the biceps: the unity of conservatism and progress. Symbolic structure of the wings: 12 feathers on each of them reflect a sacred union and the equality of the Federation. 3 rows of feathers embody goodness, truth and beauty. Red shield is associated with courage, heroism, Russian historical tradition, golden color eagle - with dignity, glory and eternity. Sceptre is a symbol of sovereignty, power - power and integrity. Three Crowns now interpreted in a secular sense, the unity of the legislative, executive and judicial power.
