


My Working Day

friends at school and I like to see them.**

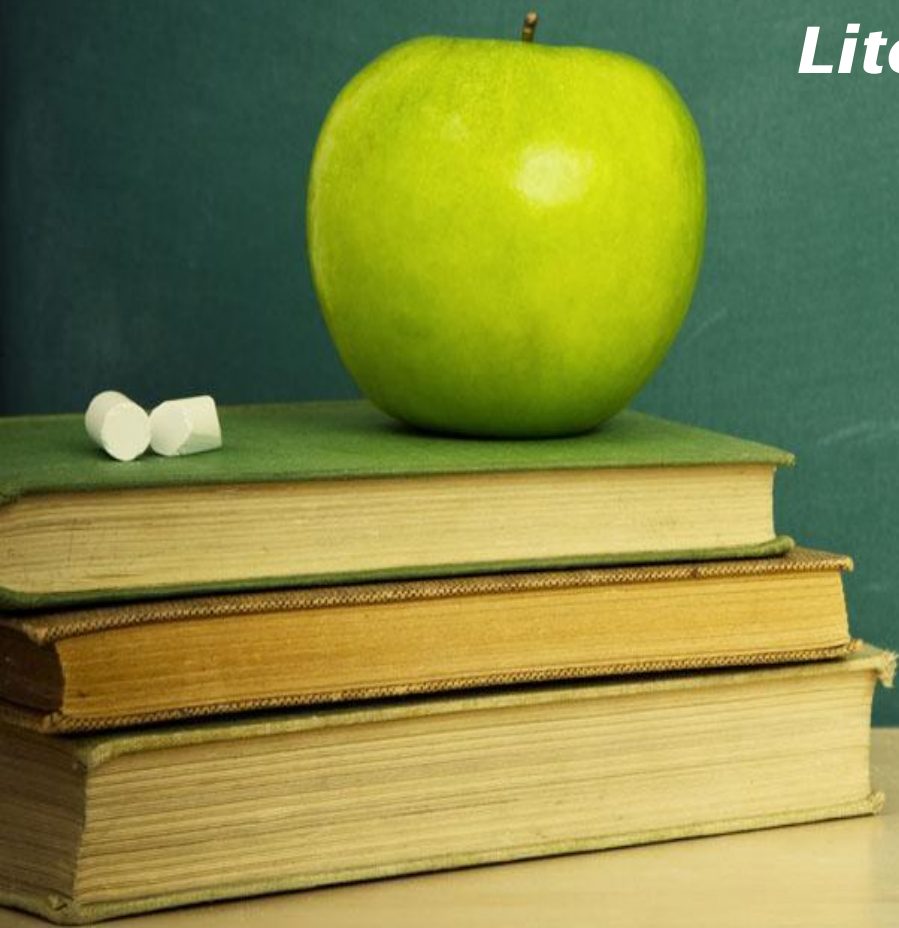

And I don't mind Music, Crafts, Geography, Art, History and Information Science.



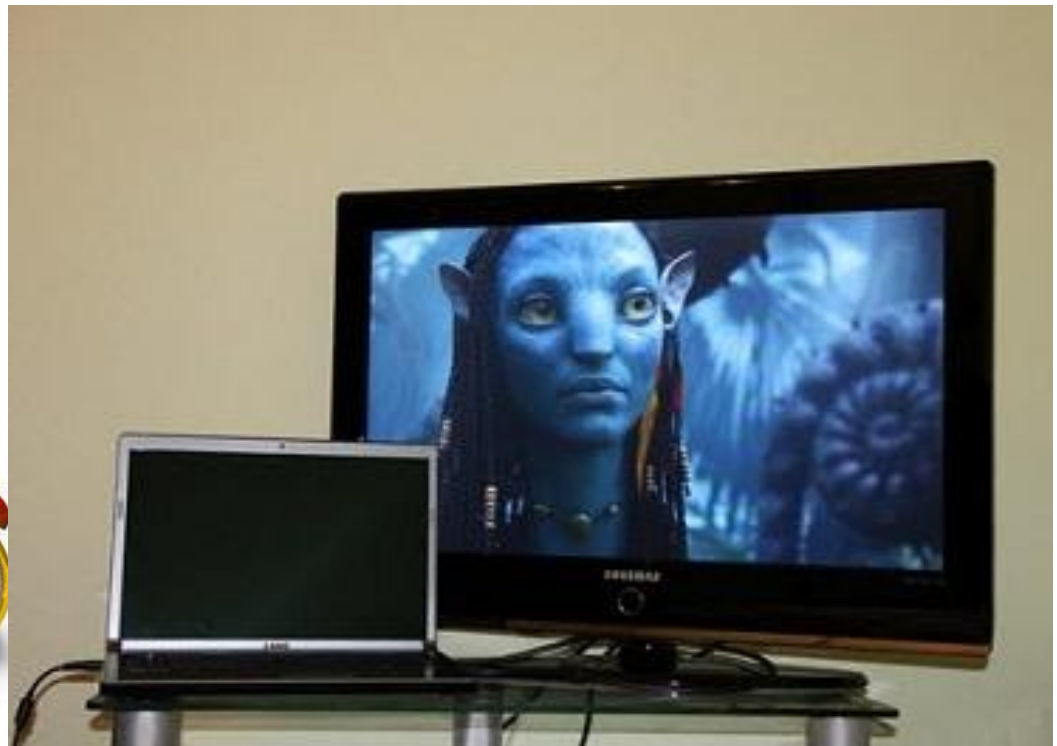
At 3.10 p.m. the lessons finish and we go home. I have dinner at home and go to the chess club.
