THE UNITED KINGDOM

- ▶ It is situated on the British Isles
- ▶ It consists of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
- ▶ the capital – London
- ▶ The head of the country – the queen
- ▶ It is constitutional monarchy
- ▶ It is governed by the Cabinet with twenty ministers and the Prime Minister
- ▶ The Parliament consists of the House of Lords and the House of Commons

GREAT BRITAIN

- ▶ The capital – London
 - ▶ Three smaller parts – England (London), Wales (Cardiff), Scotland (Edinburgh)

ENGLAND

- ▶ it is divided into 36 counties
- ▶ The country is highly industrialised.
- ▶ There is a very rich architecture – churches, cathedrals built in the beginning of the 12th century
- ▶ London – the capital city
- ▶ Birmingham – the 2nd largest city, center of engineering and motor vehicle manufacture
- ▶ Other big cities – Leeds, Manchester, Brighton, Cambridge

- ▶ The capital – Cardiff
- ▶ It is largely mountainous country, famous for its long rivers, wide lakes and high hills
- ▶ People speak English and Welsh (Celtic language)
- ▶ It is rich in cultural history
- ▶ People are known for their love of music and poetry
- ▶ Coal-mining – Cardiff and Swansea

WALES

SCOTLAND

- ▶ The capital – Edinburgh
- ▶ Country full of traditions, colour and romance
- ▶ People are very independent and proud of their culture, they speak many dialects of English, Gaelic, and an ancient Scottish language
- ▶ Country of hills, lakes, deep valleys
- ▶ Highlands – the most beautiful part of Scotland
- ▶ Lakes – Loch Lomond and Loch Ness (known for Nessie, monster)
- ▶ Cities – Glasgow (shipbuilding), Edinburgh (engineering, electronic industries), Dundee, Aberdeen (sport centre)

NORTHERN IRELAND

- ▶ The capital – Belfast
- ▶ It is situated in the northern part of Ireland
- ▶ Belfast is shopping, educational, commercial, service and entertainment centre
- ▶ There are small farms producing pigs, cattle, milk and eggs

- ▶ The capital – Dublin
- ▶ Population – almost 4 mil. people
- ▶ Towns – Cork, Limerick, Waterford
- ▶ People are mainly catholics
