#### SOMETHING NEEDS DOING

• IF YOU THINK THAT YOU NEED TO DO SOMETHING, AND IT WOULD BE BEST TO ASK SOMEONE ELSE TO DO IT. YOU CAN SAY THAT **SOMETHING NEEDS DOING**

• HIS HAIR IS VERY LONG AND MESSY, AND I THINK IT WOULD BE A GOOD IDEA FOR HIM TO VISIT THE

HAIRDRESSER.

#### HAVE/GET SOMETHING DONE

- NOW THAT YOU KNOW HOW TO SAY THAT SOMETHING NEEDS DOING, LET'S LOOK AT HAVING THINGS DONE.
- WE USE **HAVE/GET SOMETHING DONE** WHEN SOMEONE DOES SOMETHING FOR US, OR THEY DO SOMETHING BAD TO US

### HAVE SOMETHING DONE FORMAT

- SUBJECT + "HAVE" + OBJECT + PAST PARTICIPLE
- THEY ARE HAVING THEIR WINDSCREEN REPLACED
- YOU CAN ALSO USE "GET" INSTEAD OF "HAVE". THEY ARE INTERCHANGEABLE



• THIS MAN IS BEING PUNCHED, AND IT ISN'T MUCH FUN. IN OTHER WORDS, SOMEONE IS DOING SOMETHING BAD/UNPLEASANT TO HIM. IN THIS SITUATION, WE COULD SAY...

• HE GOT HIS FACE PUNCHED!




- IN THIS CASE WE CAN SAY.
