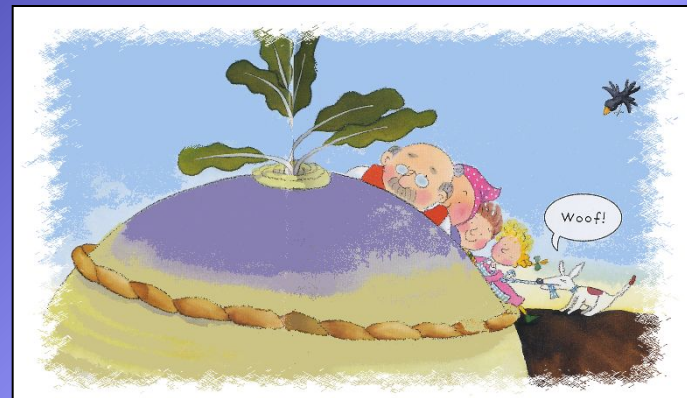


# The Enormous Turnip

And then something happened.



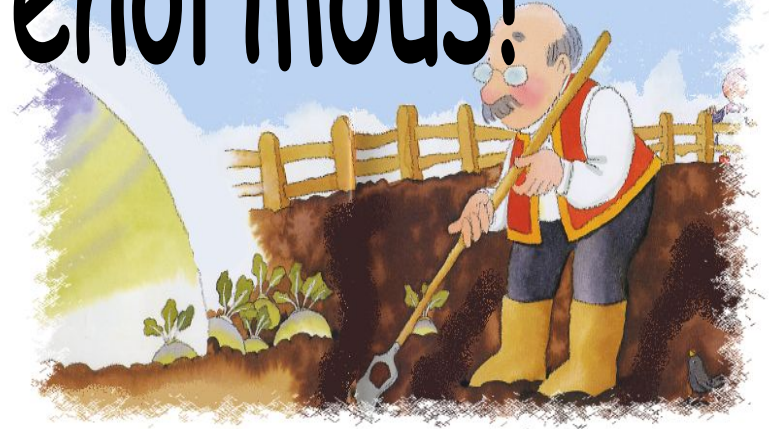
The old man woke up one morning to find that one of his turnips had grown much more than the others

The turnip was not just a big turnip.

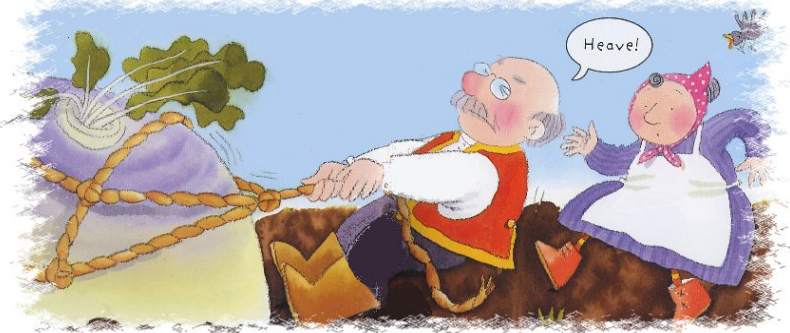
It wasn't even a very big turnip.

The girl ran to the turnip patch to help and,.....



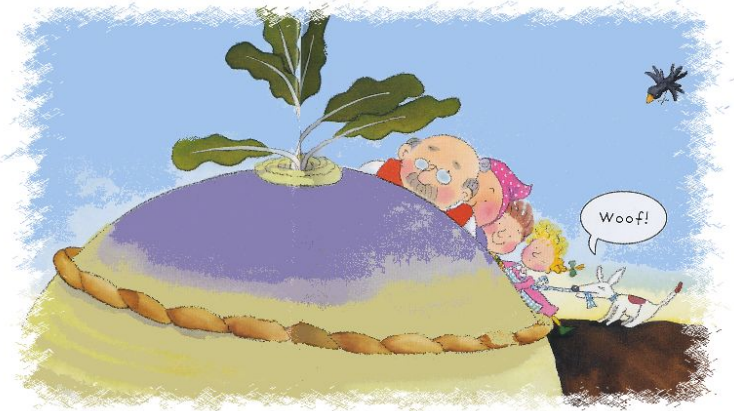
...all together, they pulled, and pulled and pulled and pulled, but the enormous turnip still would not budge!
