





Visual








Non verbal communication!

Easy presentation



Information can be easily presented in non-verbal communication

Help to illiterate people



This type of communication use gestures, facial expressions, eye contact, proximity, touching, etc. and without using any spoken or written word.





Help to handicapped people

Deaf people exchange messages through the movements of hands, fingers, eyeballs, etc.





Continuous



It is possible to stop talking in <u>verbal</u>

<u>communication</u>, but it is generally not possible to stop nonverbal

Multi channel
