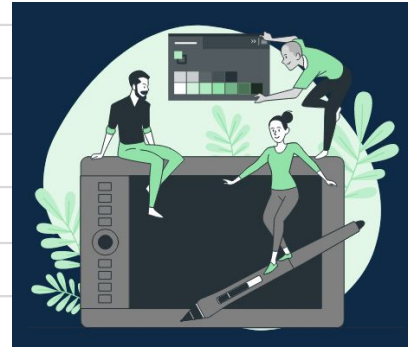
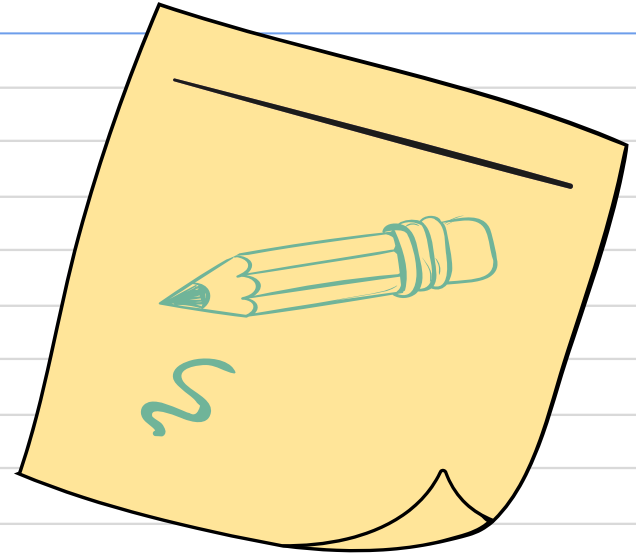
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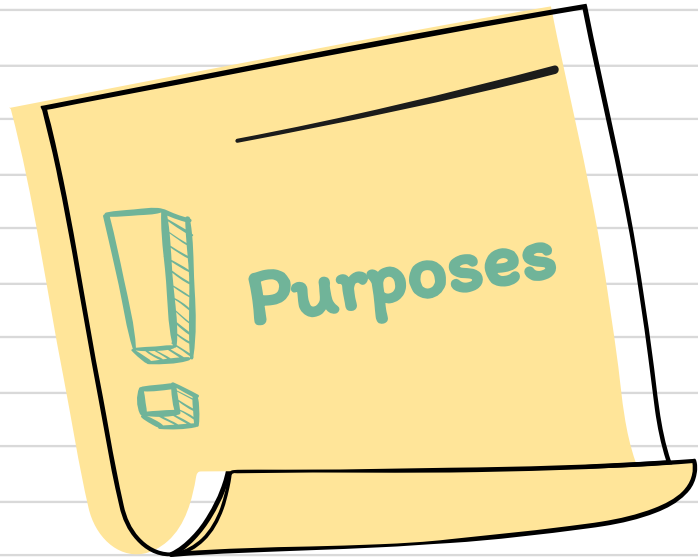


Communication !

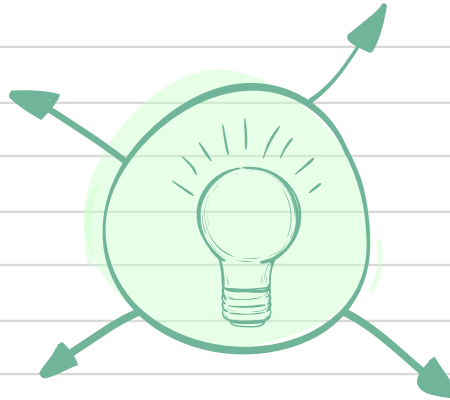

You can use physical space to communicate many different nonverbal messages,

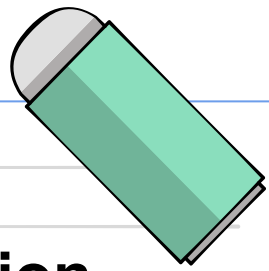
Voice.



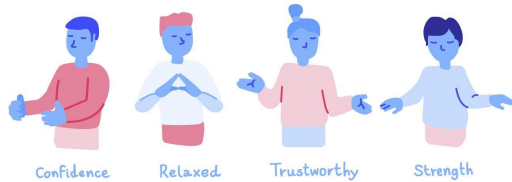
When you speak, other people “read” your voice in addition to listening to your words.

Help to illiterate people



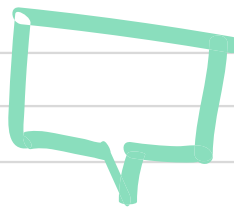
This type of communication use gestures, facial expressions, eye contact, proximity, touching, etc. and without using any spoken or written word.
