
My sport idol

Genzebe broke three world indoor records in two weeks in 2014, which helped her win the Laureus World Sportswoman of the Year award. Then she was named the **IAAF** Athlete of the Year in 2015 after breaking her first outdoor world record (1500m) and winning the 1500m title at Worlds.
