


first mentioned and defined metaphor

The Holy Bible of cognitive approach to metaphor






Metaphorical mapping / cognitive mapping


target domain





What is metaphor?

Metaphor – a process of mapping between 2 conceptual domains

The essence of metaphor – thinking about one thing in the terms of another

(life = box of chocolates anger = heated fluid in a container)

Why do we use metaphors?

- we can't but use them
- they are not a part of our language
- they are a part of our cognition
- the process of thinking metaphorical nature

Conceptual Metaphors

 sustainable correspondence between source domains and target domains fixed in the linguistic and cultural tradition of the community

- He shot down all of my arguments
- Your claims are indefensible
- I've never won an argument with him



Orientational Metaphors

based with our physical and / or cultural experience

are connected with our orientation in the space



HAPPY IS UP / SAD IS DOWN

- I'm feeling up today
- My spirits rose
- I'm feeling down
- I fell into a depression

CONSCIOUS IS UP/ UNCONSCIOUS IS DOWN

- I'm up already
- He fell asleep
- He is under hypnosis
- He sank into a coma

HEALTH AND LIFE ARE UP/ SICKNESS AND DEATH ARE DOWN

He fell ill

She came down with flu


He dropped dead

HIGH STATUS IS UP/ LOW STATUS IS DOWN


- He is at the peak of his career
- She fell in status
- She will rise to the top
- He is at the bottom of the social hierarchy

Language metaphor




WAR IS CLEANING
