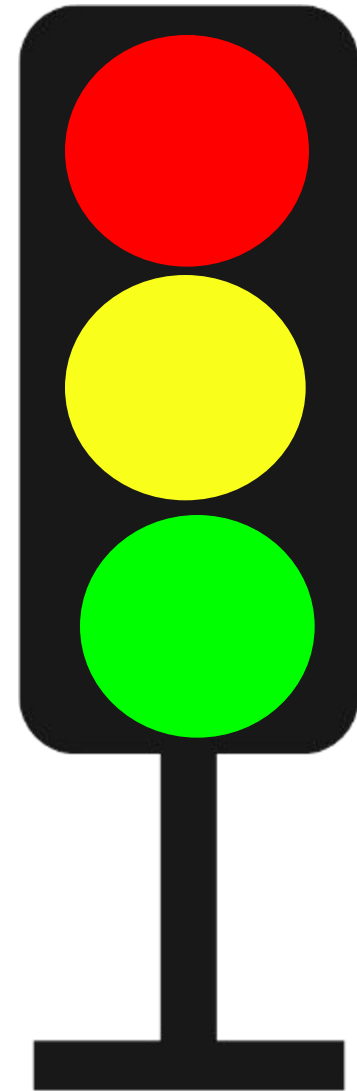

The imperative sentences

eg. **Open your books!**

Sit down!

Look at me!

We form the imperative by using the bare infinitive of the verb at the beginning of the sentence.

eg. **Don't raise your hand!**

Don't lean out of the window!

We form the negative of the imperative with don't. We use the imperative to give instructions, commands.

The imperative

Повелительное наклонение

Употребляется, чтобы:

- Отдавать приказания.
- Давать указания/инструкции.
- Предлагать что-то.
- Просить о чём-то (обычно с добавлением *please* в начале или в конце предложения).

- Повелительное наклонение глаголов совпадает с инфинитивом без частицы to: **Sit down! Садись!**
- Отрицательная форма образуется при помощи Do not=Don't и инфинитива: **Don't talk to him! Не разговаривай с ним!**
