
Steven Paul jobs (February 24, October 2011), known as Steve jobs is an American entrepreneur and inventor. He was the co-founder, Chairman of the Board of Directors and chief Executive officer of Apple Corporation.



Биография

Steven jobs was born on February 24, 1955 in mountain view, California. His childhood and youth were spent there, in the foster family of Paul and Clara jobs, to whom he was given for upbringing. At school, fascinated by electronics and gravitating to communicate with older children, jobs meets Steve Wozniak, his future colleague at Apple. Their first joint work bordered on hooliganism: the two Steves made a so-called BlueBox (lit. "Blue box") a device that allowed you to make free phone calls over long distances. Later, according to the legend, on the basis of the same scheme, they built their first joint business. Wozniak manufactured these devices during his time at Berkeley, and jobs, as a high school student, sold them.

Steve jobs and Paul Wozniak (1976) Steven jobs and Steven Wozniak became the founders of Apple. Engaged in the production of computers of its own design, it was founded on April 1, 1976, and officially registered in early 1977. The author of most of the developments was Stephen Wozniak, while jobs was the marketer.



Apple II the First personal computer introduced by Steve jobs and Steve Wozniak was the Apple I, priced at \$ 666.66 cents. Later, a new Apple II computer was created. The success of computers has made Apple a key player in the personal computer market. In December 1980, the company's first public stock sale (IPO) took place, making Steve jobs a multi-millionaire.



Apple Macintosh computers in the early 1980s, jobs was one of the first to see the commercial potential of a mouse-controlled graphical user interface, which led to the creation of the Macintosh.




Pixar Animation Studios, under jobs 'leadership, Pixar released films such as toy Story and monster Corporation, among others. Originally created as a developer of high-quality graphics hardware.



Jobs and iMac, the best-selling computer on the market (1999) In 1996, Apple announced that it would buy NeXT, bringing jobs back to the company he founded. In 1997 Steve jobs becomes Apple's interim chief Executive. In 2000, the word "temporary" disappeared from the job title»



The first iPod (2001) The incredibly compact and portable music player is equipped with buttons, built-in FM radio, pedometer, mount and many other features.



The first iPhone (2007) iPhone is a line of Quad-band multimedia smartphones developed by Apple. Smartphones combine the functionality of an iPod player, Communicator , and an Internet tablet.



The first iPad (2010) is an Internet tablet produced by Apple. The device was presented at a presentation in San Francisco by Steve jobs on January 27, 2010.



On August 24, 2011, jobs announced that he was stepping down as CEO of Apple Inc. because he could no longer "meet his responsibilities and expectations." On October 5, 2011, jobs died. The cause of death was respiratory arrest caused by a malignant pancreatic tumor. jobs ' Funeral was held on October 7, and their location was kept secret. Jobs was married. He is survived by four children.
