WOLVERINE

LENGTH OF 70-86 SEE. LONG TAIL IS 18-23 SEE. THEIR HAIR IS MAY BE DIFFERENT COLORS, LONG, ROUGH AND THICK. TEETH ARE POWERFUL AND VERY SHARP. MOST OF LIFE WOLVERINE CONDUCTS ALONE AND PROTECT ITS TERRITORY OF RIVALS. THEIR HOLES ARE IN THE ROOTS OF TREES AND IN THE ROCKS. DURING THE TWILIGHT THEY COME OUT TO EAT. THEY ARE ABLE TO CLIMB TREES. WOLVERINE IS OMNIVOROUS. THEY HAVE A SHARP SENSE AND VISION. CUBS WOLVERINES QUICKLY GETS USED TO



RACCOON

RACCOON EASILY TAMED. THE BODY LENGTH OF 45-60 CM., TAIL LENGTH 20-25 CM., WEIGHT 5-9 KG. LEGS CAN CAPTURE, HOLD FOOD AND WASH THE FOOD. RACCOON FUR THICK, BROWNISH-GRAY. THEIR HOME IS A HOLLOW. THEY ARE NOCTURNAL ANIMALS. HE KNOWS HOW TO CLIMB TREES. EAGLE EYE. HIBERNATE. RACCOON IS OMNIVOROUS.

TSUGA CANADENSIS - VERY

HE'S PRETTY AWESOME APPEARANCE - A WHITE, VELVETY SURFACE OF ITS PORES THERE PINK OR RED DROPS OF LIQUID THAT LOOKS LIKE BLOOD.

"BLEEDING TOOTH" IS NOT TOXIC, BUT IT IS NOT WORTH TRYING, BECAUSE IT HAS A BITTER TASTE, ESPECIALLY FOR SCARING PEOPLE AND PREDATORS.
