




THE MOTTO OF THE LESSON








What is the library?





RUSSIA'S STATE LIBRARY







Russia's State Library is in Moscow. It is the largest library in Europe and the second largest library in the world. It is also Moscow's first public library. The library was founded in 1862 and named the Rumyantsev Library.In 1924 the library was renamed after Lenin.In 1992 the library was renamed again and became Russian State Library. Nowadays there are thousands of ancient manuscripts and unique documents in the library.

The rules, which you must remember when you read a book

- Love books. Books are our friends
- Wash your hands before you begin to read
- Never read when you are eating
- Do not read books in bed. It's bad for your eyes.
- Do not make marks on the pages of a library books with a pen or a pencil
- Never make dog's ears in your book
- Do not tear the pages of a book

- No, really, never indeed!









I LIKE TO READ BOOKS
