2. MAIN FEATURES OF THE CULTURE.

COSMOCENTRIC OUTLOOK - UNIVERSE (COSMOS) - HIGHEST POWER THAT REPRESENTED ORDER, BEAUTY AND HARMONY.

- 2. <u>POLIS STRUCTURE</u> CITY-STATE SPECIAL FORM OF POLITICAL GOVERNMENT DEMOCRACY. GAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO REALIZE ONESELF AS EQUAL AMONG EQUALS.
- 3. <u>ENTERTAINING CHARACTER</u> THEATRE, SPORT EVENTS, CELEBRATIONS IN HONOUR OF GODS.
- 4. <u>PUBLICITY</u> CULTURE WAS NOT A PRIVILEGE OF ARISTOCRACY, DEVELOPED SYSTEM OF EDUCATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF WRITING.
- 5. <u>ANTHROPOCENTRISM</u> PERSON IS THE CENTER OF THE SYSTEM OF CULTURAL VALUES.
- 6. <u>AGONALITY</u> (AGON=CONTEST, CHALLENGE) ASPIRATION FOR SUPERIORITY

- <u>ATHENS</u> – COUNCIL _____ 3 MAGISTRATES (ARCHONS); IN 500 B.C. – <u>DEMOCRACY</u> WAS INTRODUCED.


EARLY ATHENIAN LAWGIVERS

1. <u>DRACO</u> - (7TH CENTURY BC), ATHENIAN LEGISLATOR. HIS LAW WAS NOTORIOUS FOR ITS SEVERITY (THE DEATH PENALTY EVEN FOR TRIVIAL CRIMES)

- had no rights.






