




## IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776. A DECLARATION BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN GENERAL CONGRESS ASSEMBLED.

H E N in the Course of human Events, it becomes neceffary for one People to difforve the Political Bands which have connected them with another, and to affume among the Powers of the Earth, the separate and equal Station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent Respect to the Opinions of Mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the Separation.

We hold these Truths to be felf-evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain umilienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Purfuit of Happiness – That to fecure these Rights, Governments are inflituted among Men, deriving their just Powers from the Confent of the Governed, that whenever any Form of Government becomes deltructive of these Ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to inflitute new Government, hying its Foundation on fuch Principles, and organizing its Powers in fuch Form, as to them fhull feem molt likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Produce, indeed, will dictate that Governments long eftablished thould not be changed for light and transient Caufes; and accordingly all Experience hath thewn, that Mankind are more disposed to fuffer, while Evils are fufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the Forms to which they are accultomed. But when a long Train of Abutes and Usurpations, purfaing invariably the fame Object, evinces a Delign to reduce them under abiolute Desposition, it is their Right, it is their Duty, to throw off fuch Government, and to provide new Guards for their future Security. Such has been the patient Sufferance of these Colonies; and fuch is now the Necetility which confirms them to alter their former Systems of Government. The Hilfory of the prefert King of Great-Erit and is a Hilfory of repeated Injuries and Usurpations, all having in direct Object the Etablishment of an abfolute Tyranny over these States. To prove this, let Facts be fubmitted to a candid World. His has refused his Affent to Laws, the most wholeform and neceffary for the public Good.
