
STUDENTS

Princeton students can obtain a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science in Engineering. Despite the fact that each department has its own requirements, all students must listen to a certain number of courses that are outside of their specialization and can achieve universal knowledge and skills. Thus, all students are required to listen to the minimum number of courses in the areas of Art and Literature, history, sociology, epistemology and cognition, ethics, morality, science, science and technology. Students also need to learn a foreign language for three or four semesters and listen to a seminar on creative writing.
