A LITTLE/LITTLE

Мы используем **a little/little** с неисчисляемыми существительными (water, money, rice...).

A little имеет значение «немного, но достаточно».

Например: I've got **a little** money. I can buy some bread.

Little означает «совсем мало, почти ничего» и для усиления используется с **very**.

Например: I've got **very little** money. I can't buy any bread.

A FEW/FEW

Мы используем **a few/few** с исчисляемыми существительными во множественном числе (tomatoes, books, cups...).

A few значит «немного, несколько, но достаточно».

Например: There are **a few** tomatoes. We can make a salad.

Few означает «совсем мало, очень мало» и для усиления часто употребляется с **very**.

Например: There are **very few** people in the cinema. It is almost empty.

A FEW / A LITTLE

*Chairs, water, tea, books, chocolate,
bread, men, deer, jam, glasses, honey,
knives, children, Coke, butter, lemonade,
salt, desks, hats, pepper.*

VERY FEW, A FEW, VERY LITTLE, A LITTLE.
