Smog – icky, brown air pollution that comes from cars and factories; it makes the air unsafe for people, animals, and plants to breathe.





The greenhouse effect – when gases from factories, electric power plants, and cars trap the sun's heat and warm up the Earth.





Acid rain – when harmful gases from cars and power plants are released into the air and fall back to the Earth with rain or snow.










Wastewater – water carrying dissolved or floating solids from homes, farms, businesses or industries.
