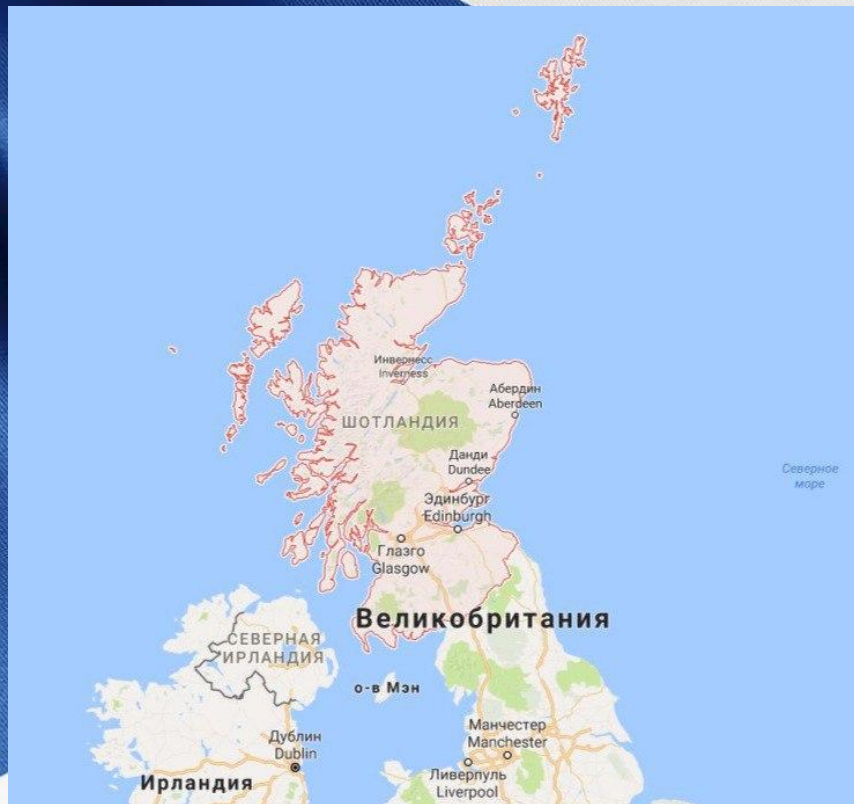


# Scotland





Scotland is the north part of Great Britain. Five million people live in Scotland. Edinburgh is the capital of Scotland.



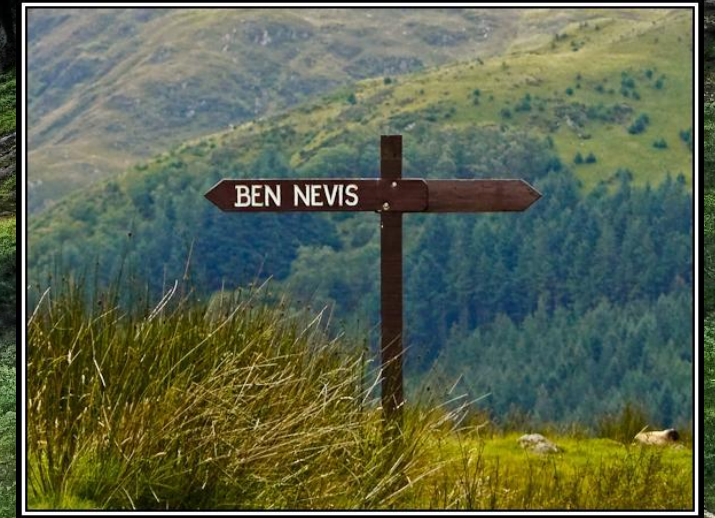
