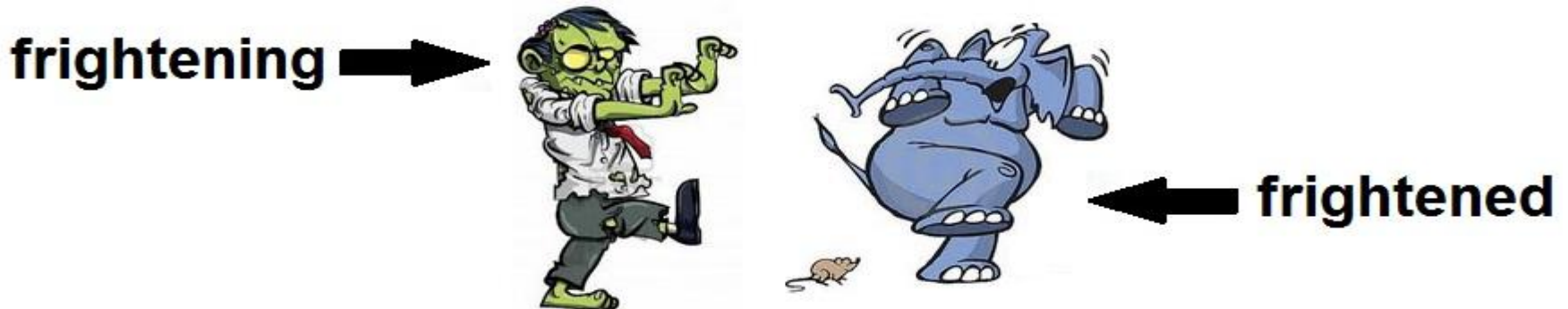


Word formation

- ed, - ing

▣ ***frightened*** ' and ***frightening*** ' can be used as adjectives, but they describe things in different ways

Ex: On Halloween the costumes are frightening, that's why I'm frightened to go out this day.

annoying →




← annoyed

- ▣ **interested — interesting** (заинтересованный — интересный)
 - ▣ **excited – exciting** (взволнованный – волнующий)
 - ▣ **frightened – frightening** (напуганный – пугающий)
 - ▣ **shocked – shocking** (шокированный – шокирующий)
 - ▣ **surprised – surprising** (удивленный – удивительный)
 - ▣ **embarrassed – embarrassing** (смущенный – смущающий, неловкий)
 - ▣ **annoyed – annoying** (раздраженный раздражающий, досаждающий, нервирующий)
