



Hearing


You will: Study the structure of ear •We hear with our ears. Ear consist of three parts: **outer** ear, **middle** ear and **inner** ear.



- Outer ear consists of external pinna and the ear canal.
- •Pinna collects the waves and sends them to the ear canal. There sound waves hit the eardrum.



- In the middle ear there are three bones. They accept vibrations from the eardrum and send to the inner ear.
- Also, middle ear has **Eustachian tube**. It connects ear and pharynx. This tube equalizes the pressure inside and outside of the eardrum.



• The **inner ear** consists of **cochlea** and **semicircular canals**. There are special receptors in the cochlea. They send information from sound vibrations to the brain.
