# Age for enrollment

- Ideal education: children enter school when they are 7 years old. A year before that, children can go to additional school classes.



# Elementary school

- Primary school lasts from 6 to 12 years of age. At this time, students do not have to sit all the time for lessons. It is also correct to cancel the primary school exams.



# Collectivism

- All children, regardless of their level of knowledge, study together. This is the reason that the difference between the weakest and the strongest student will be minimal.



# Number of students

- The maximum number of students in a class is 15. This allows teachers to pay attention to each student, and children to spend more time doing practical tasks.

# Secondary school
