FUTURE CONTINUES IN USE

The future continuous tense isn't taught very much in English classes but, in fact, English speakers use it a lot. You will sound much more natural if you master this tense.



- We mainly use the Future Continuous to indicate that we will be in the middle of doing something in a specified time in the future. There are also two other uses, listed below:
- Use
- Future actions in progress
- Guesses about the present or the future
- Polite questions about somebody's intention

Future Continuous

will be + V-ing



I will be going	I will NOT be going	Will I be going?
YOU WE will be going THEY	YOU WE will NOT be going THEY	YOU Will WE be going? THEY
HE SHE will be going IT	HE SHE will NOT be going IT	Will SHE be going? IT

In the same way as with the future simple, usually we use the short form ('ll be verb-ing) when we are speaking. As with the positive, we usually use the short form (won't + be + verb-ing) whenspeaking.





- Affirmative: He'll be going to the local polyclinic at 9 o'clock tomorrow.
- Negative: He won't be going to the local polyclinic at 9 o'clock tomorrow.
- Interrogative: Will he be going to the local polyclinic at 9 o'clock tomorrow?



• Affirmative: I'll be having warm applications at 2 o'clock tomorrow.

 Negative: I won't be having warm applications at 2 o'clock tomorrow.

• Interrogative: Will I be having warm applications at 2 o'clock tomorrow?



- Affirmative: The physician will be making the diagnosis to my mother at 5 o'clock tomorrow.
- Negative: Will the physician be making the diagnosis to my mother at 5 o'clock tomorrow?
- Interrogative: The physician won't be making the diagnosis to my mother at 5 o'clock tomorrow.



- Affirmative: His temperature will be falling, I expect.
- Negative: His temperature won't be falling, I expect.
- Interrogative: Will his temperature be falling, won't it?
