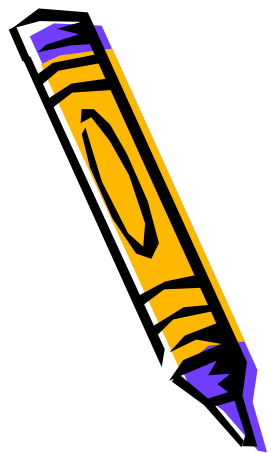

COMPARE. PASSIVE SIMPLE.

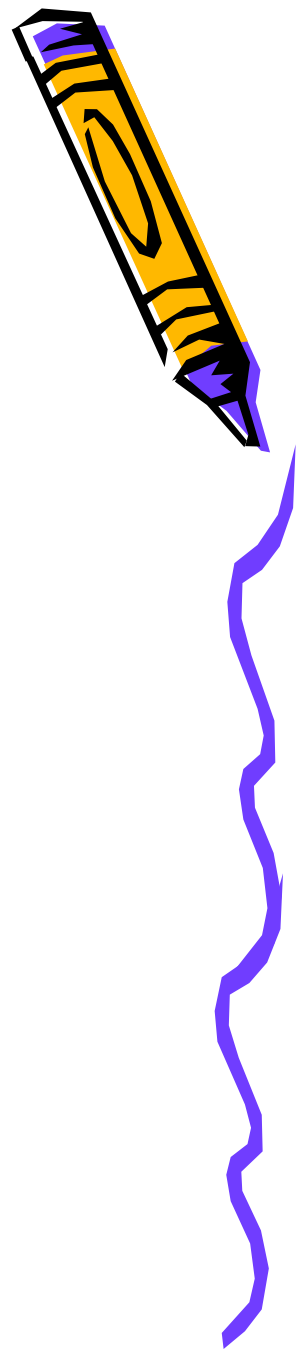
• Present

- *Ago*



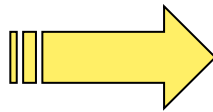

Future Simple Passive?

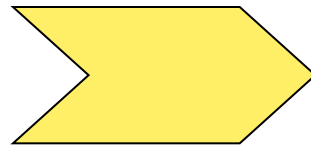


shall, will be + V3
