#### We use **THE** with:

 names of oceans, rivers, seas and canals:

Oceans – the Atlantic, the Pacific, the Indian Rivers – the Rio Grande, the Thames, the Nile Seas – the Baltic Sea, the Red Sea, the Mediterranean Canals – the Suez Canal, the Panama Canal



### But there is usually no **THE** with:

• lakes:

Lake Victoria,Lake Eire,Lake Titicaca



#### We use **THE** with:

mountain ranges:

 the Alps,
 the Andes,
 the Rocky Mountains

groups of islands:

the Bahamas, the Canary Islands



#### But there is no **THE** with:

- single mountain tops / peaks:
  - Mount Blank,
  - Mount Everest,
    - Mount Etna
- single islands:

Bermuda

Tenerife

## There is usually no **THE** with:

- names of continents, countries, states, towns:
  - Africa,
  - France,
  - Florida,
  - Vilnius



#### We use **THE** with:

- plural names of countries:
   the Netherlands,
   the Philippines
- names that include Republic, State, Kingdom, Federation): the Czech Republic
