

- Italy the 11th century.
- France the 14th Century,
- England tables –1658

The two-prong twig the first fork. By the seventh century, small forks were used at Middle Eastern courts Eating with a fork once scandalous. While forks a regular feature on the tables of nobles in Italy since the 11th Century, and used in France in the 14th Century, it in England only in 1611 by Thomas Coryat. In England the fork was slow to gain. In 1608, Thomas Coryate the "grand tour" of Europe, and in Italy hea fork. He liked it. Hesome forks and showed them to his friends. Coryate's friends at him. 
