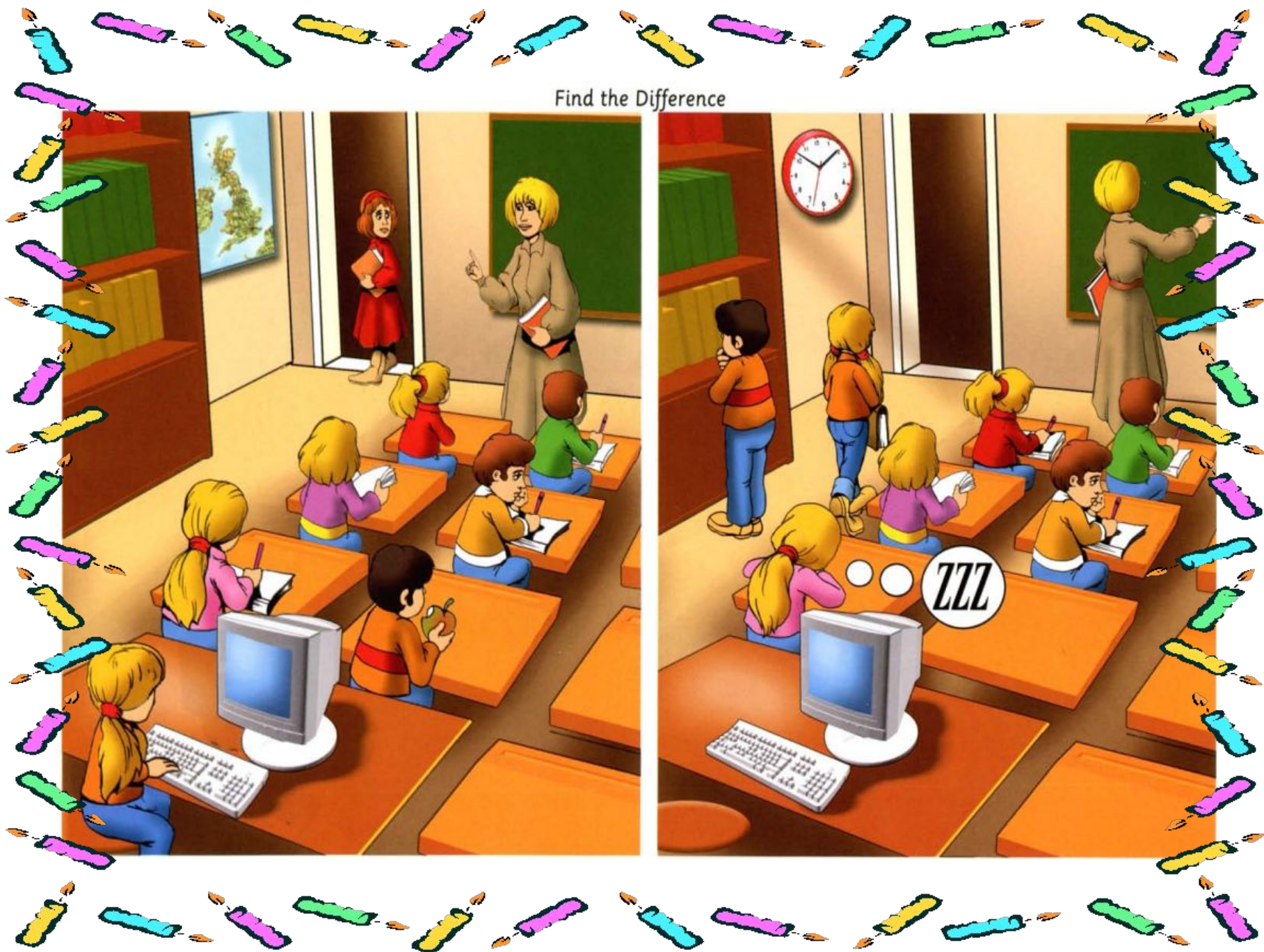
We are talking. – We are not working.

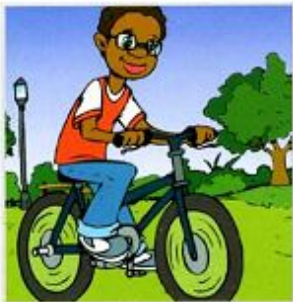

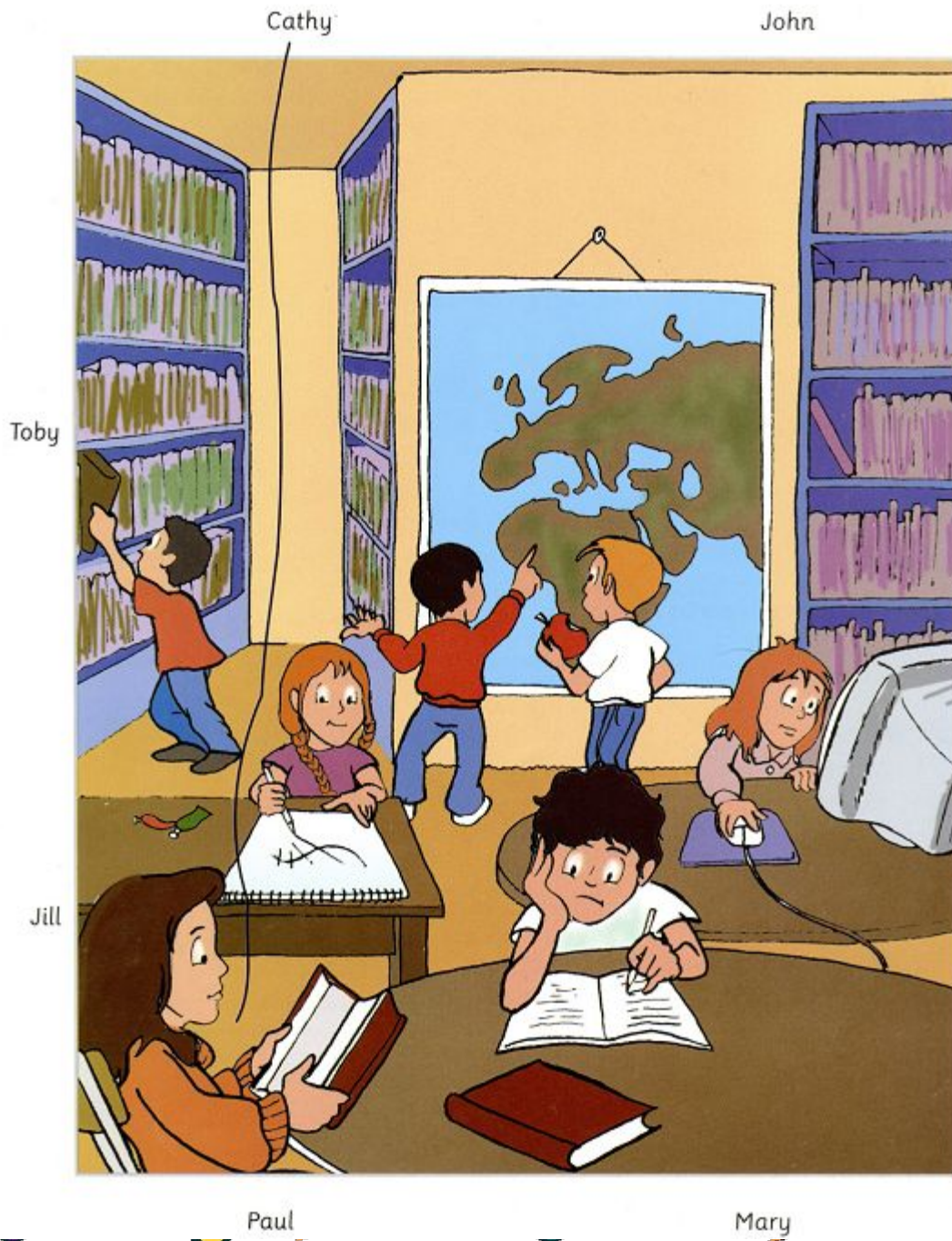
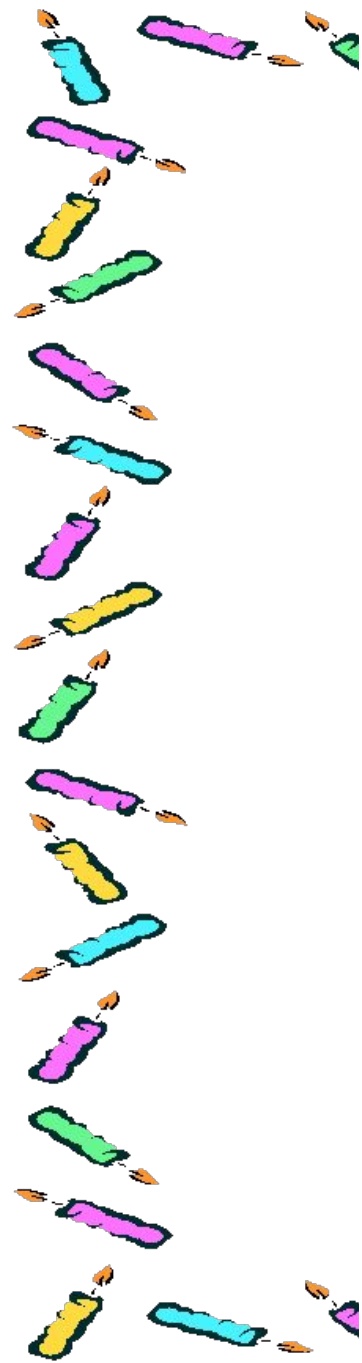
