Adjective or adverb

Adjectives modify nouns.
She is very quiet.

Adverbs modify verbs.
She speaks very quietly.

adjective + **ly** → adverb
quick → quickly
sudden → suddenly

fast hard late early are
adjectives and adverbs
He is a **fast** runner.
He can run **fast**. (not '**fastly**')

good (adjective) → well (adverb)

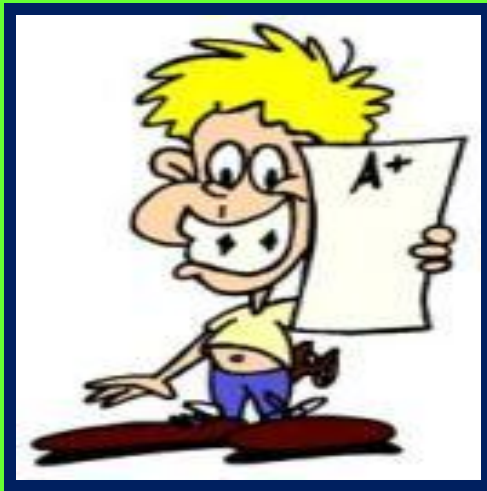
loud

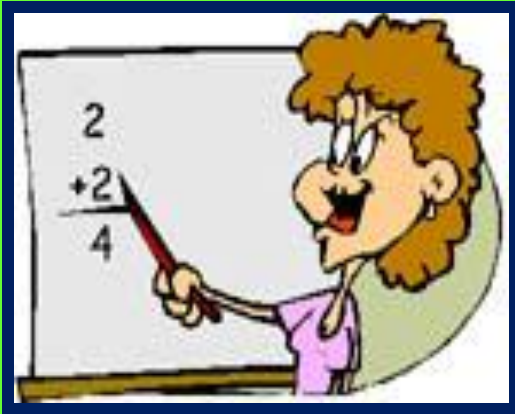
good
