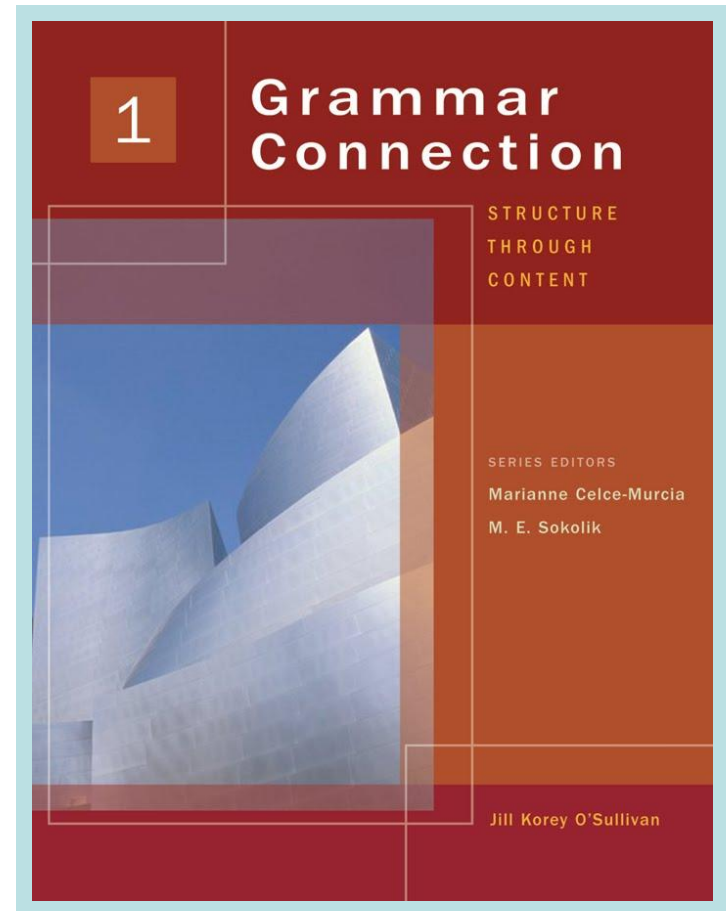

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# Grammar in Content

Hi, Lisha! Yeah, I am at home now. I am drawing. It's for art class... Oh, yes. You are hearing my music. I like to work with music on...

It is snowing outside?  
Awesome! I love snow!

# Present Progressive Verbs: Affirmative

I	am	thinking	I'm		thinking
He She It	is	drawing	He's She's It's		drawing
You* We They	are	listening to music	You're We're They're		listening to music

\*You is either singular or plural.

# Present Progressive: Affirmative

Complete the chart.

Subject	be		Contraction	
I	am	thinking.	I'm	thinking.
He She It	is	drawing.	He's She's It's	drawing.
You* We They	are	listening to music.	You're We're They're	listening to music.

\*You is either singular or plural.



Use the present progressive to talk about things that are happening right now.

You can use *it* with the present progressive to talk about the weather.

*It is raining. It is snowing.*

To form the present progressive, add *-ing* to the end of most verbs. Verbs with special spellings will be covered later in the lesson.

*They are teaching. He is looking.*

# Spelling Verbs in the *-ing* Form

Look at the chart.

Base form	<i>-ing</i> form	Rules for most verbs:
work eat	working eating	Add <i>-ing</i> .
live write	living writing	For verbs ending in a consonant + e: Drop the e and add <i>-ing</i> . (Do not double the consonant: <del>Writting</del> )
sit plan	sitting planning	For verbs that end in one vowel and one consonant: Double the consonant and add <i>-ing</i> .
say sleep listen think	saying sleeping listening thinking	Do not double the last consonant before <i>-ing</i> when the verb: ends in w, x, or y. ends in two vowels and one consonant. has more than one syllable (when first syllable is stressed). ends in two or more consonants.

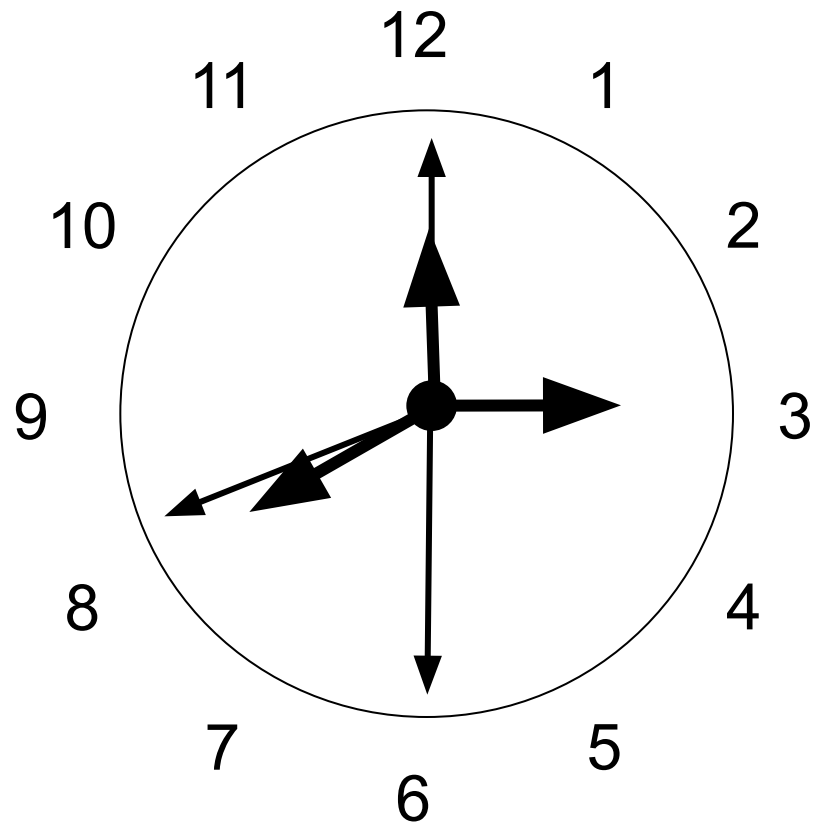
