Правила добавления окончания **-ing** в Present Continuous:

- **e** – немое убираем;
- согласный на конце, перед которым стоит ОДНА ударная гласная, удваиваем.
- liv**e** – liv**ing**
- p**u**t – pu**t****ing**

- I **am** writing a letter.
- He **is** reading.
- They **are** making a pizza.

Negatives



I am ('m) not

You are not (aren't)

He is not (isn't)

She is not (isn't)

It is not (isn't)

We are not (aren't)

They are not (aren't)

+ singing.

Present Continuous or Present Simple



1. Linda usually (get up) late at weekends.

Linda usually **gets up** late at weekends.

2. I (play) tennis at the moment.

I **am playing** tennis at the moment.

3. Barbara (listen) to music in her free time.

Barbara **listens** to music in her free time.

4. The sun often (shine) brightly in summer.

The sun often **shines** brightly in summer.

5. Sarah (have lunch) now.

Sarah is **having lunch** now.
