







Is Baia do Sancho, in Brazil. It is found in the archipelago of Fernando de Noronha, just over an hour by air from Natal. Here, 21 islands form a marine park that draws divers from far and wide to see green and hawksbill turtles, whales, lemon and reef sharks, clownfish, anemones and parrotfish.



Brasilia, the country's capital, took just 41 months to build, from 1956 to 1960 (Rio had been the capital for the previous 197 years).
