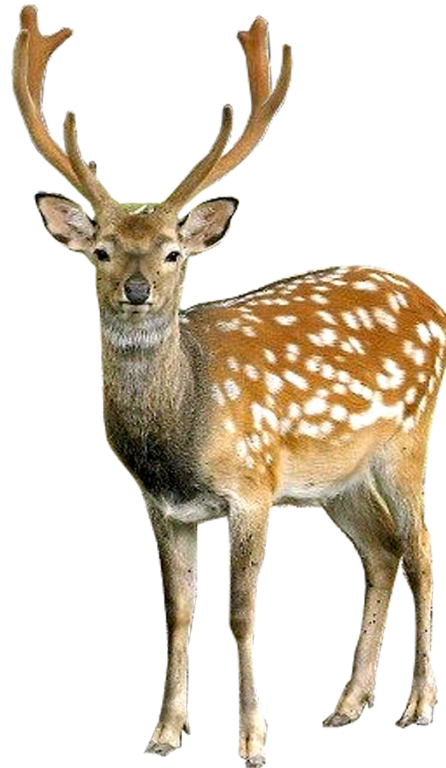

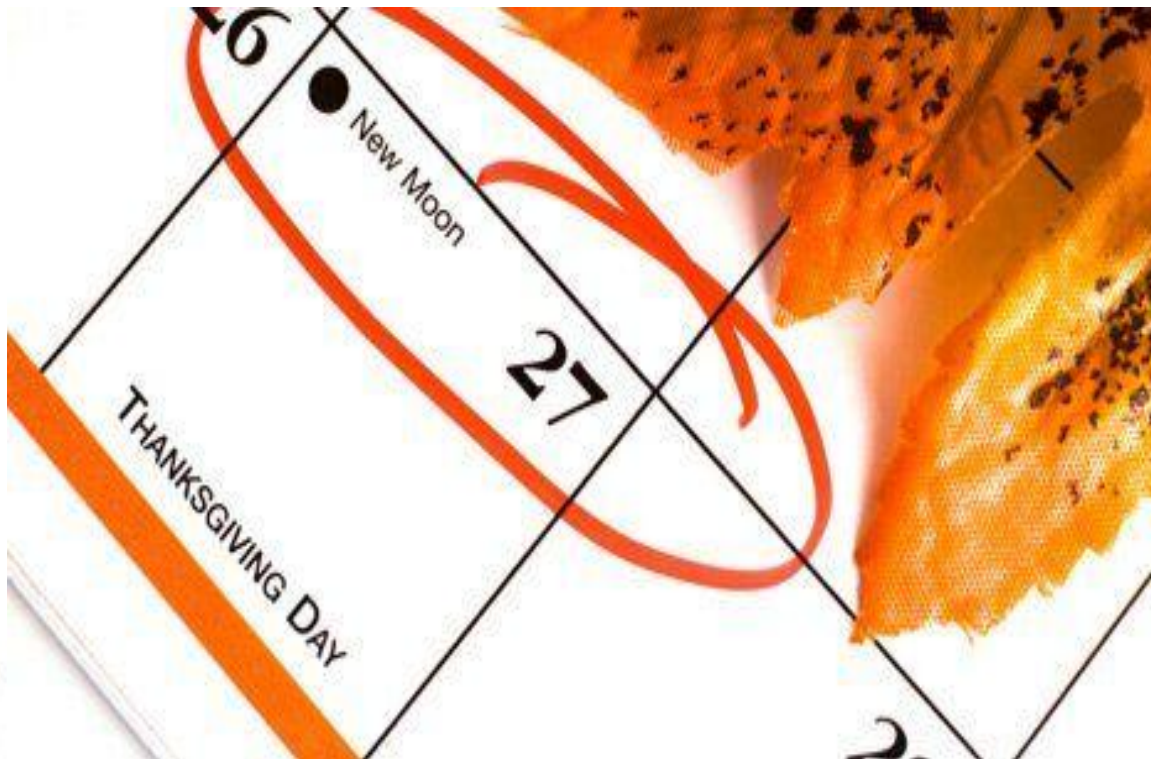

Prep: 10 min | Cook: 65 min | Cool: 2 hr | Servings: 8



Ingredients:

| ¾ cup granulated sugar | 1 can (15 oz) Libby's 100% Pure Pumpkin |
| 1 tsp ground cinnamon | 1 can (12 fluid oz) Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk |
| ½ tsp salt | 1 unbaked 9-inch (4-cup volume) deep-dish pie shell |
| ½ tsp ground ginger | Whipped cream |
| ¼ tsp ground cloves | |
| 2 large eggs | |

Directions:

1. Mix sugar, cinnamon, salt, ginger, and cloves in a small bowl. Beat eggs in a large bowl. Stir in pumpkin and sugar-spice mixture. Gradually stir in evaporated milk.
2. Pour into pie shell.
3. Bake in preheated 425°F oven for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350°F; bake for 40 to 50 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack for 2 hours. Serve immediately or refrigerate. Top with whipped cream before serving.

Note: Do not freeze, as this will cause the crust to separate from the filling.

Lobby's Famous Pumpkin Pie

Ingredients:

¾ cup granulated sugar	1 can (15 oz) Lobby's 100% Pure Pumpkin
1 tsp ground cinnamon	1 can (12 fluid oz) Nestlé Carnation Evaporated Milk
¼ tsp salt	1 unbaked 9-inch (8-cup volume) deep-dish pie shell

Directions:

Prep: 10 min | Cook: 45 min | Cool: 2 hr | Servings: 8

1. Mix sugar, cinnamon, salt, ginger, and cloves in a small bowl. Beat eggs in a large bowl. Stir in pumpkin and sugar-spice mixture. Gradually stir in evaporated milk.
2. Pour into pie shell.
3. Bake in preheated 425°F oven for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350°F; bake for 40 to 50 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack for 2 hours. Serve immediately or refrigerate. Top with whipped cream before serving.

Note: Do not freeze, as this will cause the crust to separate from the filling.

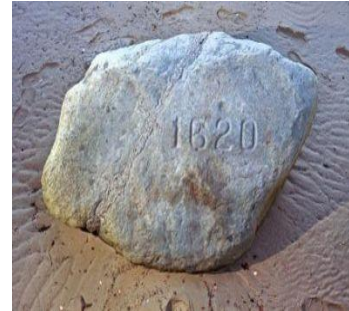
