Amazon.com, Inc., is an American electronic commerce and cloud computing company based in Seattle, Washington that was founded by Jeff Bezos on July 5, 1994. The tech giant is the largest Internet retailer in the world measured by revenue and market capitalization, and second largest after Alibaba Group in terms of total sales. The amazon.com website started as an online bookstore and later diversified to sell video download/streaming, MP3 downloads/streaming, audio book downloads/streaming, software, video games, electronics, apparel, furniture, food, toys, and jewelry. The company also produces consumer electronics—Kindle e-readers, Firetablets, Fire TV, and Echo—and is the world's largest provider of cloud infrastructure services (laaS and PaaS). Amazon also sells certain low-end products like USB cables under its in-house brand AmazonBasics.
