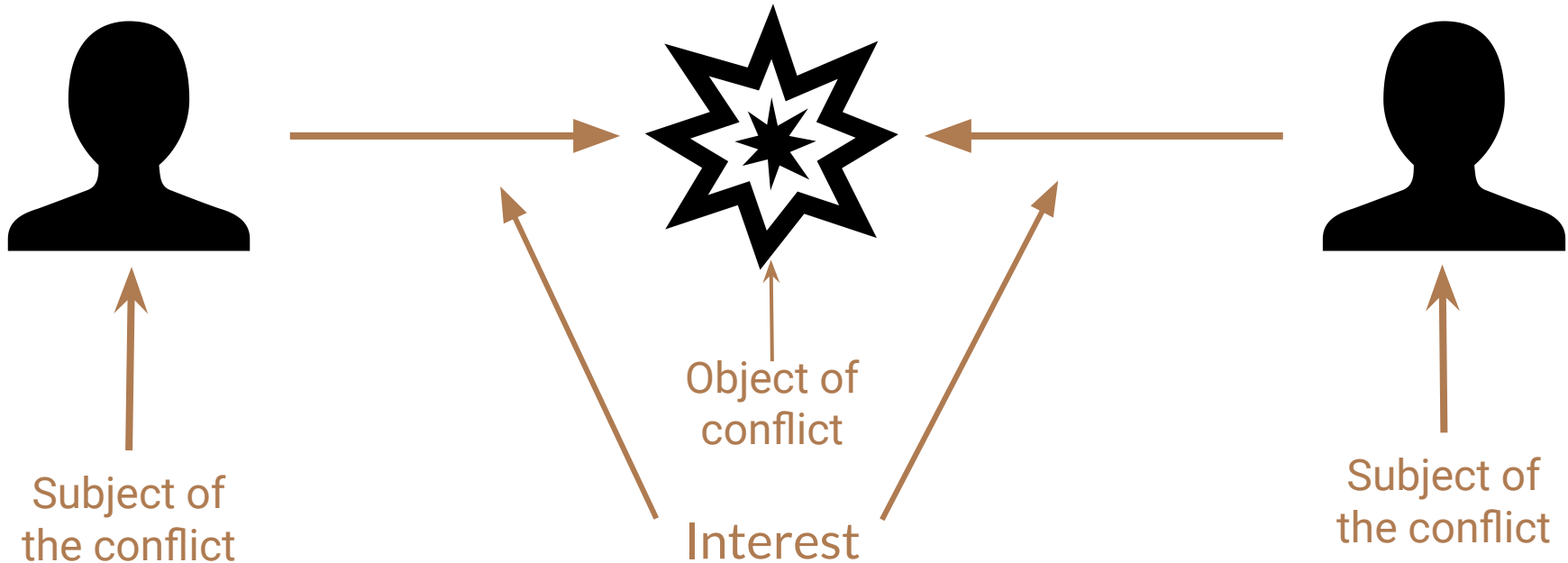

What is conflict?



Conflict

Conflict - a clash of people (groups of people) on the basis of the intersection of their interests



The cause of the conflict is a conflict of interests

Signs of conflict

```
graph TD; A[Signs of conflict] --> B[Bipolarity]; A --> C[Activity]; A --> D[Subject of the conflict]; B --> E[By bipolarity (opposition), it is customary to understand parallel opposition and interconnectedness, which contains the internal potential of the existing conflict. However, the presence of bipolarity does not yet indicate any form of disagreement.]; C --> F[Activity is perceived here as a struggle. For its appearance, you need a "push" coming from one of the parties to the conflict.]; D --> G[The subject of the conflict acts as an active party interested in clarifying the relationship. Most often, the subjects of the incident are characterized by conflict thinking.];

Bipolarity

By bipolarity (opposition), it is customary to understand parallel opposition and interconnectedness, which contains the internal potential of the existing conflict. However, the presence of bipolarity does not yet indicate any form of disagreement.

Activity

Activity is perceived here as a struggle. For its appearance, you need a "push" coming from one of the parties to the conflict.

Subject of the conflict

The subject of the conflict acts as an active party interested in clarifying the relationship. Most often, the subjects of the incident are characterized by conflict thinking.

Incidents that ultimately lead to positive consequences. Below are their distinguishing features.

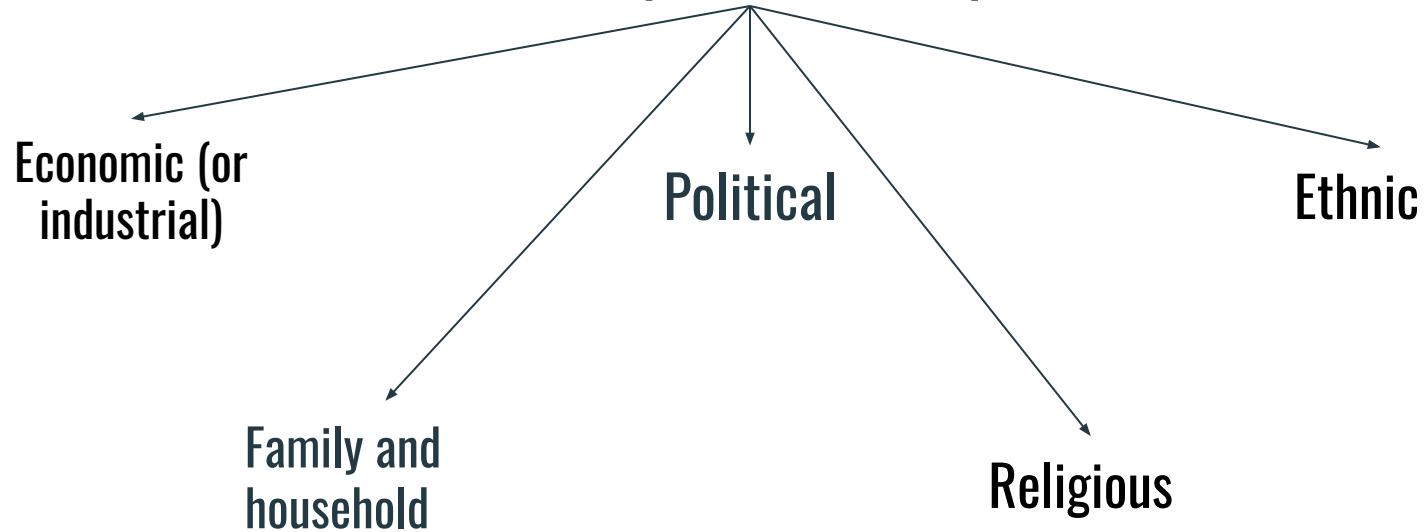
Destructive

Incidents leading to negative consequences. In such cases, both sides are unable to find any compromise to solve the problem.

International conflicts

Conflicts between countries can occur for a variety of reasons. Some of the most common of them are territorial contradictions, ideological, due to interference in internal affairs, due to attempts to control the resources of the other side, etc. Acute conflicts between countries are accompanied by information wars. The most acute form of conflicts between countries is war.
