

Racquetball



Racquetball, a sport in which players are located on opposite sides of the divided grid of fields and throws the shuttle over the net racket strikes, trying to win the game.

Rules

Under the rules of the game is carried out to 21 points.

The player is the winner of a separate drawing in the following cases:

Shuttlecock hit the opponent's area.

The opponent sent the shuttle outside the playing field.

The opponent was fouled.

The opponent during a rally significantly touched the net body or racket, or not filed with the filing of the shuttle.



History
