Adjectives and adverbs

How to use?


Adjectives:

Kind shy cold angry wonderful bad unusual mad



Adverbs:

Kindly Shy<u>ly</u> coldly angri<u>ly</u> wonderfully **badly** unusual<u>ly</u> madly



We use adjectives

to say how something

- is
- becomes
- looks
- feels
- sounds
- tastes
- smells



Examples

1.She is kind.

2.It is getting cold.



We use adverbs

with other verbs to say

how something

- happens
- is done



Examples



1.She spoke kindly but shyly.

2.He closed the door <u>angrily.</u>

We use adverbs

before

- adjectives
- past participles
- other adverbs
- prepositional expressions

Example



It is growing unusually <u>fast</u>.

Some verbs are used with both adjectives and adverbs

adjective

1.You look angry (=You seem angry.)

adverb

1.He looked angrily at... (=He turned his eyes...)
