

ПРЕДЛОГИ ВРЕМЕНИ AT/ON/IN

AT, ON, IN

- **At** используется с указанием часов и минут и со словами "полночь" и "полдень":
- I start work **at** 8 o'clock.
- The shops close **at** 5.30 p.m.
- We met **at** midnight.

AT, ON, IN

- **On** используется с днями, недели, с числами месяца, с названиями праздничных дней:
- Good-bye! See you **on** Friday.
- The concert is **on** 22 November.
(читается "on the twenty-second of November").
- I will meet you **on** New Year's Day.

AT, ON, IN

- **In** используется с месяцами, с годами, с названиями времен года:
- I'm going on holiday **in** October.
- Jill left school **in** 1984.
- The garden is lovely **in** spring.

Кроме того, существуют устоявшиеся выражения:

- **At the weekend** Are you going away at the weekend?
- **At night** I can't sleep at night.
- **At Christmas/Easter** In Britain children get presents at Christmas.
- **(HO on Christmas Day)**
- **At the end of...** I'm going on holiday at the end of October.
- **At the moment** Are you busy at the moment?

- In the morning/in the afternoon/in the evening — (вообще) по утрам/днем/по вечерам:
- I always feel good in the morning. — Я всегда чувствую себя хорошо по утрам.

НО

- On Monday morning/on Tuesday afternoon/on Friday evening/on Saturday night и так далее:
- I'm meeting Jack on Monday morning.

IN также имеет значение "через":

- **In five minutes/in a few days/in six weeks/in two years** — через пять минут/через несколько дней/через полтора месяца/через два года
- **Hurry! The train leaves in five minutes.** — Поторопись! Поезд отправляется через пять минут.

At/On/In не используются перед:

- **this** — this morning/this week и так далее
- **every** — every day/every week и так далее
- **last** — last August/last week и так далее
- **next** — next Monday/next week и так далее
- They are going on holiday next Monday.
- Last summer we went to Scotland.
