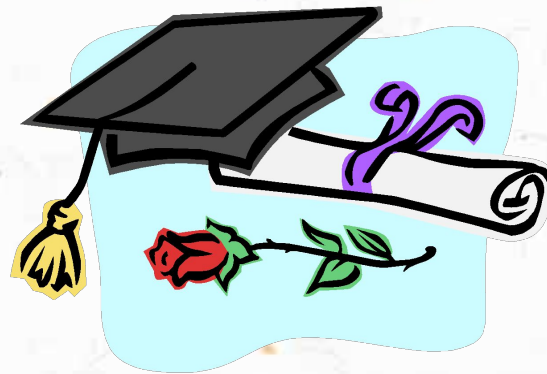
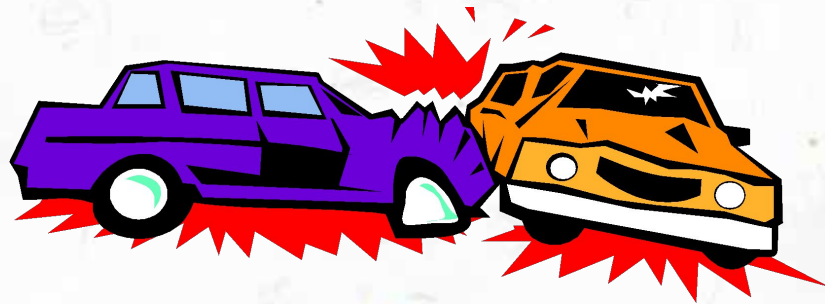

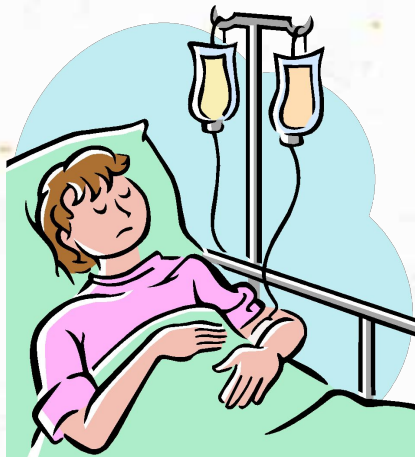

airport?**

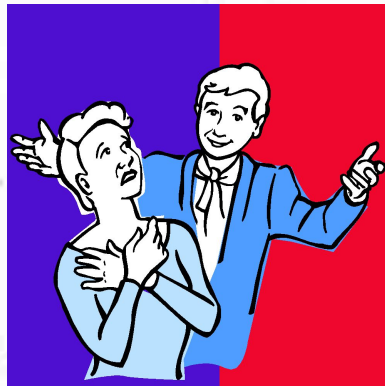
