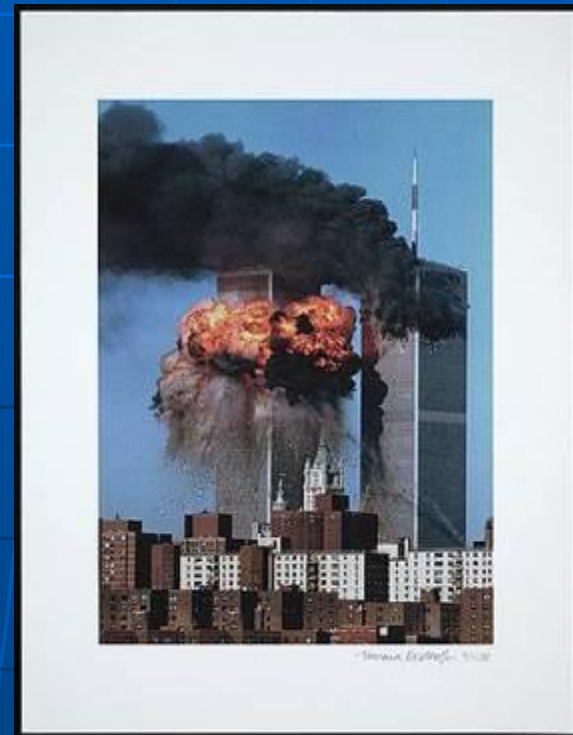
THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING
